
HAVE YOU EVER SAID ANY OF THESE THINGS?


HOW BAD COULD IT GET?

I was once right where you are right now. I was the person desperately desiring to hear the Holy Spirit speak to me the way I read and/or heard other people talk about. I felt left out of experiencing a relationship with the Lord in a way my heart immensely desired to. I sometimes gave into the thought that I must not be special enough for the Holy Spirit to speak to me the way He was speaking to others. I often felt frustrated, discouraged, and disappointed, I Thank God, that the desire He stirred within me to continue pursuing to hear Him was greater than the frustration of not hearing Him.

From the outside looking in, my life had no lack in it. I had a beautiful family that I loved and was loved by. I loved the community I was in. I loved the church I went to. I was a Sunday School teacher. Everything seemed ideal except for one area in my life – I knew there had to be more in my relationship with the Lord than what I was experiencing and being taught about at church.

I didn't know what it was exactly, but I could feel it in my innermost being that there was something more. I'd occasionally heard other people say that God had spoken to them. I didn't quite understand what they meant or how they heard Him, but I desired to hear Him with a burning desire. I couldn't shake it. I wanted to know what the "more" was that I felt I was missing out on. And I wanted to hear Him talk to me. I felt in my heart that the "more" was connected to hearing His voice so, I set out to pursue the keys to hearing Him. After some time in searching for the answers, I found them!



The first time I knew without a shadow of a doubt that the Lord had spoken to me, He gave me instructions for a woman who attended the same church as I did. Her mother had cancer and He told me to give the woman specific instructions to pass along to her mother. I wrote down what I heard then later began to second guess that I had heard the Lord speak to me at all. I questioned, "What if it was only my imagination? "

A couple of days later, I received a phone call from the woman whose mother the Lord gave me the instructions for. She told me she was unsure of why she was calling other than she knew the Holy Spirit was prompting her to and felt I had something to tell her. GOD IS SO GOOD! He confirmed to me that I had indeed heard Him and, not only heard His voice but also heard Him accurately. I gave her the message of what the Lord instructed her mother to do. Shortly after her mother's obedience in following through with His instructions, a large cancerous tumor that had been causing much discomfort for her, disappeared from her body!

To God be all the glory!







Key #1

Be Confident in Knowing it's His Will to Speak to You

When you've never experienced the Holy Spirit speaking to you, understandably it may be difficult to be confident in knowing that not only does He want to talk to you, but also in knowing that He WILL. The truth is, we receive by faith. Doubt closes the doors to our breakthroughs, but by faith we receive.

Romans 10:17 "So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God".

After talking with numerous amounts of people, I've come to realize that a great number of Believers have not been given a solid foundation from the word of which they can establish their faith upon regarding hearing the Holy Spirit. A clear understanding of scripture is necessary for faith-filled expectancy to be present. In my 90-day program, from the context of the original language in which scripture was written, I strategically establish a solid and clear understanding of what the word says about hearing the voice of the Lord.

Key #2



Set Aside Time Specifically for the Lord

We live in a world where we have constant entertainment, constant means of communication with our family, friends, and peers, and often, some type of plans constantly scheduled for us in some form or fashion. Although life has been made easier for us through various types of technology, I dare to say - by our own making, we have become a society of very preoccupied and busy people.

In any relationship, whether it be romantic, friendship, parental, or business, communication is of the utmost importance for it to prosper. For authentic communication to develop, there must be a focused span of time set aside for it.

James 4:8(α) "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you".

Just as we desire to be valued enough by those in our relationships by spending quality time with us, the Holy Spirit desires the same with us.

Throughout the years, the Lord has taught me how to free up time daily to spend with Him only during that time. He has also taught me how to abide in the secret place with Him even amid a hectic and busy schedule. Key #3



Silence the Noise Around You

Have you ever gone into a restaurant during its busiest and most chaotic time of the day and tried to have a heart-to-heart conversation with someone? I have! The background chatter makes it almost impossible to do without making frequent requests for the other person to repeat portions of the conversation. Obviously, an endearing conversation is better achieved in a less noisy and chaotic atmosphere.



I'm reminded of one of the old television commercials that was advertising hearing devices. In the commercial, an older gentleman insisted he didn't have an issue with his hearing. On the contrary though, whenever someone spoke to him, their words became unrecognizable to him as the background noise became scrambled in with the sound of the other person's voice. When he attempted to reply to the other person, his response did not synchronize correctly with the conversation at hand. Although, the commercial was meant to be humorous, there is nothing delightful about being distracted due to the noise of our surroundings that the Holy Spirit's words become undiscernible.

In our world filled with so many habitual media sounds, as well as the many other sounds that demand our attention as we go about our days, it can oftentimes seem impossible to have quiet time to ourselves. The truth is, it's not impossible. Much of what we perceive to be our normal and needed routines are nothing more than habit and familiarity, of which both can be modified with creative effort and renewed awareness.

Key #4



Quiet the Distracting Thoughts

Now that you have conquered quieting the noise around you, let's address the chatter within. It is not a secret, nor an uncommon occurrence that when we retreat into our quiet time to pray, our brain suddenly becomes filled with random thoughts. Let's be real, those thoughts flood through our minds a mile a minute, like a galaxy of shooting stars that we did not have a clue were in existence prior to our prayer time.

Our greatest obstruction to hearing the Holy Spirit can be that of our own mind if we allow it to free range in an undisciplined manner.

Mastering the ability to take thoughts captive may not seem to be an easy assignment in the forefront but with persistence you will gradually, and yet SUDDENLY realize you have become proficient at it.

Psalm 131:2 "Surely I have calmed and quieted my soul, Like a weaned child with his mother; Like a weaned child is my soul within me".




Key #5

Allow Him Opportunity to Speak

A common misunderstanding about prayer time is that it's a time to approach God with our long list of needs and wants. Yes, there is a time to petition Him for our desires according to His will, but it's not when we're approaching Him desiring to hear His voice. I'm not saying we shouldn't talk to Him at all during this time. On the contrary, a conversation consists of both parties engaging, but what I am saying is, we shouldn't talk so much that He can't get a word in edgewise.

Another misconception about praying is that we tend to believe if we're not talking nonstop, then we've ceased to pray. Let's approach this misconception with the scenario of a conversation taking place amongst a couple of good friends. Now, let's imagine they spent the day together and in their excitement afterward, they stated what a great and fulfilling visit they had together because they 'talked nonstop'. In hearing that statement, would we conclude that they both talked at the same time continuously? Of course not. Rather, we would conclude that they had a long conversation between themselves whereas, while one spoke the other listened, then vice versa.

There's a time to be heard AND there's a time to be quiet for the purpose of hearing Him. Consequently, once we experience the Lord's voice, we quickly ascertain that what we hear and receive in our time of being quiet before the Lord supersedes the desire to listen to our own voice over His.



Psalm 46:10 He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."
