Kidd Mine produces an average of 40,000 tonnes of copper and 70,000 of zinc annually.

Kidd Mine is the world's deepest base-metal mine below sea level reaching 10000 feet. The mine also has the longest surface-to-bottom ramp in the world. We transport our ore by rail to our Kidd Concentrator/Mill located 27km from the mine.

We are one of the largest private-sector employers in the City of Timmins with a workforce of approximately 800 including full-time employees and contractors.

To meet the challenges of deep mining, we employ a highly skilled workforce and use leading edge technology like automated loaders and ventilation-on-demand. With a constant focus on achieving zero harm, we are committed to safety, the development of our people, and the sustainability of our community and environment.
