

An Update on COVID-19 and our performances.

In light of the current COVID-19 crisis that we are all facing, The Flying Bookworm Theatre Company is instituting some changes to ensure the ongoing health and safety of our actors and the schools we visit.

PERFORMANCES.

- During the COVID-19 crisis we are limiting the maximum audience size for a show to 40 students.
- If you currently have a booking of over 40 students, we will be in touch about splitting the show into two or more sessions, to ensure the smaller group numbers are met.
- We are also offering to re-schedule performances for a later date in the year at no additional charge, if that is preferred.
- During this time we will not be using costumes for students during audience participation, we will instead be focusing on the ways in which imagination and physicality can represent characters.
- Our teams will only be visiting 1 school per day.
- These changes are currently set to apply to all shows until 31st of May 2020

PERFORMERS.

For the time being all Flying Bookworm performers are required to check in daily with health updates and any sign of illness will result in the Performer being placed on a 14 day self isolation, or until they confirmed to be fully healthy.

We can confirm our actors have not :

- Been overseas in the past 3 months
- Exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19
- Come into contact with anyone who has diagnosis of COVID-19.

The health and safety of everyone has always been, and continues to be, our primary concern, and we look forward to working with you on maintaining the well being of your students, staff and our team.
