Help Us Bring the Firehouse to Marrowstone this Summer/Autumn!



The Marrowstone Firehouse Crew Quarters

As you may know, the Marrowstone Island Foundation (MIF) has been engaged in a multi-year effort to purchase and secure the installation of a building on Marrowstone Island to house volunteer firefighters and EMTs. East Jefferson Fire and Rescue (EJFR) has agreed to pay for the foundation, utility connections, installation, and delays, if any, and all future maintenance of the building. In addition, EJFR, in conjunction with MIF, is committed to recruiting and training volunteers to support EJFR's current, robust, volunteer program. The crew quarters are seen as vital to the development of a Marrowstone Island based core of volunteer EMTs and firefighters.

HAVING A VOLUNTEER STAFFED FIREHOUSE ON MARROWSTONE ISLAND:

- Will significantly reduce response time in case of medical emergencies or fire. Current 911 emergency response times from off island stations, on average, exceed 14 minutes (the national average is 8 minutes). During a pilot study in June 2021, stationing EJFR volunteers on Marrowstone (in their cars not a sustainable option) the response time was reduced to 6.5 minutes. Seven and a half minutes will make a big difference if you have a heart attack or a fire.
- The firehouse will also strengthen the Island's ability to remain resilient during a large earthquake/tsunami, which may isolate the island for an extended period.

UPDATE:

- 1. The firehouse building is scheduled to be delivered in August, 2022.
- 2. A building permit has been issued based on EJFR site, foundation, and utility plans.
- 3. Excavation for the foundation has been completed.

WHAT ARE WE ASKING?

The total cost for the firehouse, taxes, and transportation to the site is **\$149,000**. Through the generous donations of island residents, MIF has raised over **\$128,000** to purchase a suitable building. We would like to raise an additional **\$25,000** to cover our shortfall and cover the inevitable last-minute contingencies of a project of this scope.

WHEN DOES THIS NEED TO HAPPEN?

As soon as possible; we are within 45 days of delivery of the building. Because of the dramatic fluctuations in materials costs, we only received final pricing 45 days before delivery.

ARE THERE OTHER BENEFITS FOR YOU?

Your insurance agent can determine your premium reduction, and these savings recur every year. In addition, MIF is a 501(c)(3) organization (Tax ID: 91-1036925), which means your donation is eligible to be deducted from your income taxes as a charitable contribution depending on individual taxpayer circumstances.
