

NTX SOLO SERIES RULES

We will keep the rules extremely simple. Breaking the rules will result in immediate disqualification from the event and/or future events. All tournaments in the series are OPEN however in order to compete you MUST have a paid membership.

1. Life Vest must be worn at all times the outboard motor is in gear on idle or on plane (no exceptions)
2. The kill switch MUST be attached correctly. (this is law)
3. Absolutely no Alcohol can be consumed during tournament hours.
4. Only boats that are in compliance with law (registration) are allowed. (NO KAYAKS)
5. Not more than one angler is allowed on the boat at all times during tournament hours.
6. Practice will end SUNDAY. at 11.59 pm the week before the tournament.
7. At ALL times you must keep a distance of 25 yards from any other angler fishing the tournament.
8. All areas marked OFF LIMITS means you CAN NOT fish in that area.
9. All bridges are considered NO WAKE ZONES no exceptions.
10. All areas marked NO WAKE means just that. Idle speed only.
11. You may only use ONE rod and reel at a time. And no trolling will be allowed at all.
12. All baits used MUST be artificial. All fish caught must be caught and NOT snagged.
13. All bass will need to measure 14 inches (except Spots) also please understand the slot requirement on certain lakes.
14. If you are a High School young man you must present your boaters license.
15. If there is a TIE. it will be the places combined money and split. Same will apply for AOY points.
16. All tournaments will be a numbered start. 10 boats or 50 boats wont matter it will be a numbered start. You will draw your number at registration at each event.
17. Points will start from 150 and go down 1 point each finish. In other words first place 150 second place 149 and so on.
18. You MUST Pay for all 4 events to qualify for the championship round. You must have 4 paid entries. HOWEVER you may choose to fish one or all as all the events are OPEN except the championship.

Please make sure you READ and follow all rules listed above. Good luck to everyone and I hope we have a great season.
