



Summer Transportation Program

Objective: To provide transportation to families with children registered in the H.E.L.P Program to meal sites throughout the Summer. Doing so will give our community the ability to close the child hunger gap between meals in the Summer between school years.

How it works: There have been specially designed laminated bus passes that the Lincoln County Transit bus drivers will recognize as a program participant to avoid any possible embarrassment from the families. The bus pass will become valid on the day after school is out and expires on the first day of school in the fall. A child and an adult must be present in order to redeem the pass.

Since this is the first run of this program, we have to leave room to expand the program for future grants so this year the transportation will be limited to meal sites only. The meal site list through the Lincoln County School District is what will be used to determine which bus stops are closest to the meal sites in order for drop off and pick up availability.

Materials to families: In the bus pass package, a season pass, bus schedule (with correct bus stops highlighted) and list of meal sites will be provided to all families participating in this program so they are aware of where the meal sites are and which bus stops will accept their passes.
