## YOUTH MASTERS TOURNAMENT

1. TOURNAMENT OPEN to Tucson, Metro Area 2025-2026 USBC Youth Division sanctioned bowlers. Entrants may enter tournament only once. All entrants must abide by USBC Youth membership eligibility rule 400.
2. EVENT This is a single scratch or handicap tournament. You will have three games of qualifying. Depending on entries there will be either match play or a step ladder to determine the winner. There are two divisions – Scratch and Handicap.
3. AVERAGES to be used must be USBC certified averages.
  - a. Youth entrants with a USBC 2024-2025 book average of 12 games or more must use highest book average. Sports and challenge averages will be converted according to USBC rule.
  - b. Youth bowlers will use a current average of 12 games or more as of November 8, 2025.
  - c. Bowlers with no average will enter with a 200 average.
  - d. All entrants for whom no verification has been received will use 200. USBC Rule 319a2, D, E is waived.
4. HANDICAP will be 90% of the difference of 230.
5. ENTRY FEES will be \$20.00 per person (\$12.00 Lineage, \$7.00 Awards, \$1.00 Expenses). Entry fees must accompany entry and are non-refundable. Money order, Check, or League/Booster club check made to Tucson Metro USBC. Entry Fee Must accompany entry.
6. AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS: Scholarships monies will be deposited in SMART Account. Awards and Scholarship Fees returned 100%.
7. CHECK IN one half (1/2) hour prior to squad time. If not checked in ten (10) minutes prior to squad time, you may be replaced.
8. DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire must be worn; neat, clean and fitting properly. Tattered blouses, shirts, and pants are not allowed. Shirts and Blouses must be hip length if not tucked in. No hats will be allowed. USBC Rule 301b – Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Tournament Director decision is final.
9. GENERAL:
  - a. No food or drinks in the bowling area – must be kept on the back counter or table.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: Entries close on December 3, 2025. If space is available, late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director.

All Rules not covered will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules
