TUCSON YOUTH CITY TOURNAMENT

1. Tournament open to 2025-2026 USBC Certified Youth Division bowlers in good standing. All entrants must abide by USBC Youth Membership Eligibility Rule 400.
2. Tournament Events are team, doubles, and singles. Entrants will roll three (3) games in each event. In all divisions, those entering doubles and singles must bowl both events. Doubles and Singles will be bowled on same pair of lanes. Entrants may not enter an event more than once.
3. Age Classification is the entrants age as of August 1, 2025; Majors 15-17 years, Junior 12-14 years, Prep 9-11 years, Bantam 8 years and under.
4. Divisions will be major, junior, prep and bantam. Teams may be mixed, all girls or all boys. If entrants from more than one age classification compete on team and doubles, division will be the older age classification. Singles and All Events will be in the entrants' own age division. NOTE: If the Bantam team and double/singles requirement (4 teams – 8 sets doubles/singles) is not met, then there will be a Prep-Bantam Division for Team and Doubles.
5. AVERAGES to be used must be USBC certified averages.
 - a. Youth entrants with a USBC 2024-2025 book average of 12 games or more must use highest book average. Sports and challenge averages will be converted according to USBC rule.
 - b. Youth bowlers, if no book averages, will use a current average of 12 games or more as of January 31. 2026.
 - c. Bowlers with no average will enter with a 220 average.
6. All entrants for whom no verification has been received will use 220. USBC Rule 319a2, D, E is waived.
7. HANDICAP will be 90% of the difference of 220.
8. ENTRY FEES will be \$25.00 per person (\$18.00 Lineage, \$5.00 Awards, \$2.00 Expenses). Optional All Events Fee: \$5.00). Entry fees must accompany entry and are non-refundable. Money order, Check, or League/Booster club check made to Tucson Metro USBC. You can also Zelle the money to am@tucsonmetrousb.com
9. AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS: Scholarships monies will be deposited in SMART Accounts. Awards and Scholarship Fees returned 100%. Awards will be given out at a minimum of 1 in 5 per division. Scratch takes precedent over Handicap.
10. CHECK IN forty-five minutes prior to squad time. If not checked in ten (10) minutes prior to squad time, you may be replaced.
11. Tournament of Champions: TBD. The following is Tucson YBC Criteria for Eligibility.
 - a. Handicap Teams: Actual 1st Place Handicap Team in all divisions. Bantam Team requirement must be met otherwise the following: Bantam Handicap team will be the first-place boy and girl of handicap All Events plus the next two Handicap All Events regardless of gender
 - b. Scratch Team will be the four highest Scratch All Events regardless of age or gender.
 - c. Singles Handicap Event will be the 1st place Handicap Winners of all Events boy and girl per division
 - d. Singles Event Scratch will be the Highest All Events Scratch Score per boy and girl regardless of division
 - e. If a bowler qualifies for both handicap and scratch team, they will stay with handicap team.
 - f. The next highest scratch of all events will be selected.

- g. Handicap team that needs a substitute has the option of selecting sub. If a handicap singles substitute is needed, one will be selected from placement in that division.
- h. Singles scratch substitute next eligible regardless of gender.
- i. All substitutes must have bowled in city tournament.

12. Absent Score: Only one absentee score per team may be used if a prepaid entrant does not show. The absentee score for each game shall be the absent member's entering average less ten pins, plus handicap (USBC Rule 322b)

13. DRESS CODE: Appropriate attire must be worn; neat, clean and fitting properly. Tattered blouses, shirts, and pants are not allowed. Shirts and Blouses must be hip length if not tucked in. No hats will be allowed. USBC Rule 301b – Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Tournament Director decision is final.

14. GENERAL:

- a. No food or drinks in the bowling area – must be kept on the back counter or table.
- b. Lineup changes within original entrants will not be permitted.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES: Entries close on January 23 2026. If space is available, late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the tournament director.

All Rules not covered will be governed by USBC Tournament Rules
