Privacy Policy

The Pebble Foundation, Inc. (“Pebble Foundation,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) respects your privacy and is committed to handling personal information responsibly and transparently.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and protect information when you visit pebblefoundation.org, contact us, make a donation, subscribe to receive communications, apply for an opportunity, or otherwise interact with Pebble Foundation.

By using our website or providing information to us, you acknowledge the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

The information we collect depends on how you interact with Pebble Foundation.

Information You Provide Directly

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide, including:

- Your name;
- Your email address;
- Your telephone number, if provided;
- Your mailing or billing address;
- Information submitted through contact, volunteer, internship, employment, application, or project-related forms;
- Information about how you learned about Pebble Foundation;

- Messages, questions, comments, and other correspondence;
- Email subscription preferences;
- Donation information, including donation amount, date, designation, and transaction status; and
- Any other information you choose to provide.

Please do not submit sensitive personal information through general website forms unless we specifically request it and it is necessary for the relevant purpose.

Donation and Payment Information

When you make a donation, payment information is collected and processed by a third-party payment processor. Depending on the transaction, this information may include your name, billing address, payment-card information, and other details required to complete the donation.

Pebble Foundation generally does not receive or store complete payment-card numbers or card-security codes. We may receive transaction records and limited information from the payment processor, such as your name, contact information, donation amount, donation date, payment status, and partial payment-method details.

Your use of a third-party payment service is also subject to that provider's privacy policy and terms.

Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our website, we and our service providers may automatically collect certain technical and usage information, including:

- Internet Protocol address;
- Browser type and version;
- Device type and operating system;
- Referring and exit pages;
- Pages viewed and links selected;
- Date and time of access;
- Approximate geographic location derived from an IP address;
- Website interaction and navigation information; and
- Cookie and similar-technology identifiers.

We may use cookies, pixels, log files, analytics tools, and similar technologies to operate the website, understand how visitors use it, diagnose technical issues, prevent abuse, and improve website performance.

2. How We Use Information

Pebble Foundation may use personal information to:

- Respond to inquiries and requests;

- Communicate with visitors, donors, applicants, volunteers, supporters, and partner organizations;
- Process and acknowledge donations;
- Provide donation receipts and maintain financial and tax records;
- Administer programs, projects, applications, internships, volunteer opportunities, and events;
- Send newsletters or organizational updates when you have subscribed or otherwise agreed to receive them;
- Maintain and improve our website, programs, and communications;
- Analyze website traffic and usage;
- Protect the security and integrity of our website and systems;
- Detect, investigate, and prevent fraud, misuse, or unlawful activity;
- Comply with legal, regulatory, accounting, reporting, and recordkeeping requirements;
- Establish, exercise, or defend legal rights; and
- Carry out other purposes disclosed when information is collected.

We may combine information received through different interactions when reasonably necessary for these purposes.

3. Email Communications

When you subscribe to our mailing list or otherwise request updates, we may send you information about Pebble Foundation's programs, projects, events, fundraising activities, and opportunities to become involved.

You may unsubscribe from promotional emails by using the unsubscribe link included in the message or by contacting us. We may continue to send non-promotional communications when necessary, including donation receipts, responses to inquiries, and legally required notices.

4. Cookies and Analytics

Our website may use first-party and third-party cookies and related technologies.

Cookies are small data files stored on a browser or device. They may be used to:

- Enable basic website functions;
- Remember preferences;
- Measure website traffic and performance;
- Understand how visitors navigate the website;
- Maintain security;
- Prevent spam and automated abuse; and
- Improve website content and user experience.

You can control or delete cookies through your browser settings. Disabling certain cookies may affect the operation or availability of some website features.

We may use third-party analytics providers. These providers may collect technical and usage information according to their own privacy policies.

5. Google reCAPTCHA

Our website may use Google reCAPTCHA to help protect forms from spam, fraud, and automated abuse. reCAPTCHA may collect device, browser, interaction, and other technical information and transmit it to Google for security analysis.

Your use of pages protected by reCAPTCHA is subject to Google's applicable privacy policy and terms of service.

6. How We Disclose Information

Pebble Foundation does not sell personal information for money.

We may disclose information in the following circumstances:

Service Providers

We may share information with organizations that perform services on our behalf, including:

- Website hosting and administration providers;
- Donation and payment processors;
- Email and communications platforms;
- Analytics providers;
- Data-storage and information-technology providers;
- Professional advisers, including accountants, auditors, consultants, and attorneys; and
- Security, fraud-prevention, and spam-protection providers.

These providers may access information only as reasonably necessary to perform services for Pebble Foundation, subject to their contractual obligations and applicable law.

Legal and Safety Purposes

We may disclose information when we reasonably believe disclosure is necessary to:

- Comply with a law, regulation, subpoena, court order, or governmental request;
- Protect the rights, property, or safety of Pebble Foundation, our visitors, donors, personnel, partners, or others;
- Investigate fraud, security incidents, or suspected unlawful conduct;
- Enforce agreements or policies; or
- Establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.

Organizational Transactions

If Pebble Foundation participates in a merger, restructuring, transfer of assets, dissolution, or similar organizational transaction, information may be disclosed or transferred as permitted by law.

With Your Direction or Consent

We may disclose information when you direct us to do so or give us permission.

7. Data Retention

We retain personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including to:

- Respond to inquiries;
- Administer donations, programs, and applications;
- Maintain appropriate donor and financial records;
- Meet legal, accounting, reporting, and tax obligations;
- Resolve disputes; and
- Protect Pebble Foundation's legal rights.

Retention periods may vary depending on the type of information, the nature of the interaction, and applicable legal requirements.

8. Data Security

Pebble Foundation uses reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect personal information from unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure.

No website, electronic transmission, payment system, or storage method can be guaranteed to be completely secure. Accordingly, we cannot guarantee the absolute security of information transmitted to or stored by us.

9. Your Privacy Choices and Rights

Depending on where you live and subject to applicable law, you may have the right to:

- Request access to personal information we maintain about you;
- Request correction of inaccurate information;
- Request deletion of certain information;
- Object to or restrict certain processing;
- Withdraw consent when processing is based on consent;
- Opt out of promotional communications; or
- Request information about how personal information is used or disclosed.

We may need to verify your identity before responding. Certain information may be exempt from a request when retention or use is permitted or required by law.

10. International Visitors

Pebble Foundation is based in the United States. If you access our website from another country, your information may be transferred to, stored in, or processed in the United States or other countries where our service providers operate.

Data-protection laws in these jurisdictions may differ from those in your country. Where required, we will handle personal information using appropriate legal safeguards.

11. Children’s Privacy

Pebble Foundation supports programs and initiatives involving young people, but this website is intended for a general audience and is not directed to children under 13.

We do not knowingly collect personal information directly from children under 13 through the website without verifiable permission from a parent or legal guardian. If we learn that a child under 13 has provided personal information without appropriate authorization, we will take reasonable steps to delete it.

13. Do Not Track Signals
