This puppy is guaranteed to be healthy at the time of sale. The Breeder does not assume any liability for any injury to the puppy after the Buyer takes possession of the puppy.

The Buyer agrees to have this puppy examined by a veterinarian within 72 hours of taking possession to assure the Buyer that the puppy is healthy. If the puppy is found to be other than healthy (excluding worms, coccidia, giardia or any other parasites common in puppies) at said veterinary visit, the puppy shall be returned to the Breeder immediately and the purchase price will be refunded. Written confirmation of health concern from the veterinarian is required.

This puppy is purebred and is registrable with Limited Registration through the American Kennel Club. Limited Registration does not allow breeding or registering offspring. The puppy is ineligible to show in the breed ring, but it may compete in other events such as Obedience, Tracking, Field Trials, Hunting Tests, Herding, Lure Coursing, Agility and Earthdog. The Buyer will be given the application for AKC registration at the time that possession is taken. Temperament of the puppy is NOT guaranteed.

The Buyer agrees to maintain the puppy's health in good condition, feed a high-quality food, The Breeder requires that you continue the puppy on Royal Canin Golden Retriever Puppy Food for at least 12 months to keep the health guarantee active, maintain good weight control and provide yearly health examinations, vaccinations/titers, heartworm tests and any other usual procedures necessary to assure good health.

The puppy has had appropriate vaccinations for its age and a record of vaccinations, dewormings, and microchip information is supplied to the Buyer.

The Buyer agrees that this puppy will not be sold or ownership transferred without the Breeder's knowledge and consent. The Buyer will not sell the puppy to a pet shop, agent, or broker.

The Buyer agrees that if at any time proper care cannot be given to the puppy, the Buyer must contact the Breeder. The Breeder will have the option either to take the puppy back or to assist the Buyer in placing the puppy in a suitable home.

The Breeder believes strongly in the value of pet insurance—especially during a puppy's first few weeks in a new home. That's why the Breeder has partnered with Trupanion to include 30 days of complimentary medical coverage as part of the Buyer's puppy's transition from the Breeder's care to the Buyer's. While activation is entirely optional, the Breeder highly encourages all families to take advantage of this protection. It offers peace of mind during a time when puppies are most prone to unexpected health concerns. Please note: The Breeder's health guarantee is active only when coverage is in place at or before pick-up. If the Buyer prefers to use another provider, they are welcome to share proof of alternate insurance instead. Full instructions will be provided in advance, and the Breeder kindly asks for confirmation of coverage before or at the time the Buyer's puppy goes home. Because puppies are significantly more likely to face unexpected vet visits in their first year, the Breeder also recommends keeping medical coverage in place for at least the first 12 months. It's one of the best ways to protect your new family member—and your peace of mind—while they grow and adjust to their new world.

Every reasonable precaution has been taken to prevent this puppy from acquiring hereditary diseases.

Should this puppy develop Hip Dysplasia (Mild, Moderate or Severe), Elbow Dysplasia, Sub-aortic Stenosis, or Cataracts deemed hereditary by 12 months of age, the Breeder will take the puppy back and replace it with a puppy of equal value as soon as available. Costs to return and receive replacement puppy are at the Buyer's expense.

Hip and/or Elbow Radiographs must be submitted to and examined by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals and results must be supplied to the Breeder. Sub-aortic Stenosis must be confirmed by Echocardiography and Doppler performed by a Board-Certified Veterinary Cardiologist and documents must be supplied to the Breeder. Eye exams must be performed by a Board-Certified Veterinary Ophthalmologist and documents must be supplied to the Breeder.

Environmental factors, like high caloric diet during the rapid growth phase, may exacerbate changes in dysplastic hips or elbows. Therefore the Breeder refuses to take responsibility for dysplasia in an overweight puppy and thus Buyer will not qualify for a replacement puppy. Veterinarian records must be made available to prove good weight control.

No replacement will be given if the puppy has not been examined by 12 months of age.

This document represents the entire agreement between the Breeder and the Adopter. No other promises or guarantees are made. The conditions of this agreement may only be changed in writing by mutual consent of both parties.

The Buyer has read and understands the Contract Agreement with Limited Registration in its entirety and agrees that all parts and portions thereof constitute a binding agreement. Further, signatures below acknowledge agreement and receipt of this agreement by both parties.
