ADVENTURE PACKAGE

This adventure package includes site admission fees; ground transportation; baggage handling fees and tips; 1st evening reception & dinner; 2nd day lunch; 2nd day dinner; 3rd day lunch; hotel accommodations, including breakfasts provided by the hotel.

NOTE ABOUT MOBILITY

There may be extensive walking and/or stairs at one or more tour site(s). While all sites make efforts to accommodate those who cannot walk more than 500 feet on gravel, it is not guaranteed. Guests who require a walker or mobility vehicle should contact Architecture Travel Companion to discuss needs in advance of making a reservation.

GETTING TO PITTSBURGH

There are regular daily flights from Orlando International Airport (MCO) to Pittsburgh International Airport (PIT), as well as flights several times each week from Sanford Orlando Airport (SFB). The first evening reception is located at the Hyatt Regency Pittsburgh Airport, which is connected to PIT via covered walkway from the terminal.

ARRIVAL + DEPARTURE

Baggage check at the Hyatt Regency Pittsburgh Airport (the hotel hosting our first evening reception) begins upon your arrival on Friday, April 21st. Event begins at 5:00 pm. The motor coach will return to PIT on Sunday, April 23rd by 5:00 pm. Departing flights should be scheduled for 6:30 pm or later.

WEATHER + WHAT TO WEAR

Daily high temperatures range in April from 60-degrees to 68-degrees, with daily low temperatures in the 41-43 degree range. Still, it is advisable to check the local Pittsburgh / Uniontown / Acme forecast before departure and prepare attire accordingly. Layers are always practical.

VENUE + HOTEL INFORMATION

The host venue for the opening night reception (dinner and a speaker) on Friday, April 21st is the Hyatt Regency Pittsburgh Airport. Tour departs by motor coach that evening after dinner to the Hampton Inn. Our host hotel from Friday, April 21st and Saturday, April 22nd is the Hampton Inn & Suites in Uniontown, Pennsylvania.

INCLUDED MEALS

Friday, April 21 - Dinner at the Hyatt Regency Pittsburgh Airport.

Saturday, April 22 - Breakfast at Hampton Inn, lunch at Polymath Park, and an Ice cream scoop at Kentuck Knob. Dinner is at a Uniontown restaurant.

Sunday, April 23rd - Breakfast at Hampton Inn, Lunch at the Fallingwater Cafe.

HOW TO REGISTER + DEADLINES

Complete the registration form and contact Architecture Travel Companion via email to let us know you are sending in your forms. You can email them or mail them. Your full payment is due by March 7, 2023 to take advantage of Early Bird Pricing. Tour seating is limited and has potential to sell out before payment deadline. Deposits of \$500 per person are due at the time of booking.

CANCELLATIONS + REFUNDS

Cancellations made before February 28, 2023 will be refunded minus a non-refundable administration fee of \$100.00. There are generally no refunds available after March 13, 2023, although we will always take situations under consideration.

OTHER: It is the participant's responsibility to arrive on Friday, April 21, 2023 at the hotel before the motor coach departs the Hyatt Regency for Uniontown after dinner. Refunds will not be made for unused or partially unused portions of the tour. (Driving your own vehicle during this adventure does not change our fees. You could incur parking fees at some locations.)

Each venue has their own rules for things such as backpacks, large purses and umbrellas. If in doubt, do not take them into a venue. We are visiting museums and some tight spaces, too.
