

Who's Who

SALLY STRUTHERS (Louise) Ms. Struthers is a two-time Emmy Award and Golden Globe Award winner for her performance in the groundbreaking series *All in the Family*. She starred in the Fox television series *9 to 5* and her own CBS series Gloria. Her recurring roles include the CBS comedy *Still Standing* and the CW's highly acclaimed *Gilmore Girls*. Sally was "heard' as the voice of the teenage dinosaur Charlene Sinclair in the ABC prime-time series *Dinosaurs*. She is the voice of Pebbles Flintstone on the *Pebbles and Bam-Bam* cartoon series and the lead female character on the popular Disney cartoon *Tailspin*.

Sally co-starred in two legendary motion pictures in the 70s: Five Easy Pieces with Jack Nicholson and The Getaway with Steve McQueen and Ali McGraw. She was featured in two independent films: Out of the Black and A Month of Sundays with Rod Steiger. Sally made a cameo appearance for actor/writer/producer Mario Van Peebles in the Sony feature Baadassss! Sally's first two Broadway forays were in Wally's Café with Rita Moreno and Jimmy Coco and in Neil Simon's female version of The Odd Couple with Brenda Vaccaro. For three years she starred as Miss Mamie Lynch on Broadway and on tour in the Tommy Tune production of Grease. In the 20th Anniversary National Tour of Annie, Sally played the coveted role of Miss Hannigan. She was named Best Actress by the Los Angeles Artistic Director Theatre Awards for her role as Louise Seger in the musical, Always...Patsy Cline. She won the 2003 and 2010 Ovation Awards as Best Featured Actress in a Musical for her performances as Agnes Gooch in Mame, and Fairy Godmother in Cinderella respectively. She has starred in regional productions of Hello, Dolly!, Anything Goes, The Fifth of July, Cat On a Hot Tin Roof, All Shook Up, The Full Monty, Fiddler on the Roof, Drowsy Chaperone, and Curtains.

For thirty years, Struthers has worked to help hungry and uneducated children everywhere visiting these children in the United States and many Third-World countries. She's filmed numerous public service announcements and documentaries on their behalf. Her favorite child is her daughter Sam.

CARTER CALVERT (Patsy Cline) Ms. Calvert is best known for originating her role in the Tony®-nominated Broadway musical *It Ain't Nothin' But The Blues* alongside Grammy® winning jazz vocalist Gregory Porter. The New York Times wrote, "Carter Calvert effervesces: her voice echoes and chimes in the night and her smoldering grip on *Fever* is positively dangerous. She is featured on the cast recording and starred in the show's

national tour. Other tours include the title role in Always...Patsy Cline opposite Sally Struthers, the featured role of 'Grizabella' in the Broadway National touring company of *CATS*, the European tour of *Smokey Joe's Café*, and an international tour of Neil Berg's *100 Years of Broadway*. Ms. Calvert received raves for her off-Broadway work in Forbidden Broadway: Comes Out Swinging and appeared in The Thing About Men opposite Tony nominee Marc Kudisch. She has originated World Premiere roles in *Forbidden Vegas*, Sparkley Clean Funeral Singers and The Great American Trailer Park Musical. Other favorites include the title role in Annie Get Your Gun and Evita.

Ms. Calvert has been touring the globe as a headliner on the prestigious Crystal Cruise line as well headlining in clubs and theaters across the country with her solo shows, A Diva Celebration, Walkin' After Midnight: A Tribute to Patsy Cline and Natural Woman: A Carole King Celebration. As a recording artist, Carter Calvert and the Roger Cohen Trio debuted at number 13 on the CMJ jazz charts (beating out Paul McCartney!). Her latest CD, It's A Man's World debuted in the top 10, received rave reviews and extensive radio play. Carter is the proud mother of her beautiful 17-year-old daughter Ella, and devoted wife to her handsomely talented drummer-husband, Roger Cohen. www.cartercalvert.com

Jayme McDaniel (Director) Most recently was an artist in residence for EMK Productions in Seoul, South Korea where he has choreographed and/or co-directed Rebecca The Musical, The Man Who Laughs, Xcalibur, Monte Cristo, Yeston/Kopit's Phantom! as well as Marie Antoinette, Hamlet: The Rock Opera and The Last Kiss. He has also served as Artistic Supervisor for Elisabeth. In the USA he directed what the NY Times hails as a "joyous' production of Anything Goes starring Andrea McArdle and Sally Struthers for Gateway and Ogunquit Playhouses as well as a sold-out run of White Christmas for the Ogunquit Playhouse at the Music Hall. At Ogunquit he also directed and choreographed Joseph.., starring Clay Aiken (winning Broadway World awards for best direction and choreography) as well as Singin' in the Rain which received an IRNE nomination for best choreography. As a Stage Director he Directed and/or Choreographed Joseph.. at North Shore Music Theatre, Singin' in the Rain, Grey Gardens, Yankee Doodle & The Rocky Horror Show at the Ordway; The Student Prince at Paper Mill Playhouse; Zorba & H.M.S. Pinafore for the Berkshire Theatre Festival, Violet, Candide & Drood with Connecticut Repertory; Always Patsy Cline, The Who's Tommy, Evita, It's a Fabulous Life, Chicago, Zombie Prom, The Merry Widow, People Like Us, They're Playing Our Song and many others. As an Associate Director &/or Choreographer: Laughing Room Only (Broadway), White Christmas,

Wonderful Town, Sound of Music, (5th Ave Theatre), Yankee Doodle Dandy (5th Ave, Dallas Summer Musicals, Theatre of the Stars) Camelot & Rags (Paper Mill), Nefertiti (Parker Playhouse) Crazy for You (Musical Theatre West) & The Music Man (CLOSBC). As an arts administrator he was the Associate Producer for the Ogunquit Playhouse and the Associate Artistic Director for the Ordway Center or the Performing Arts. He's also enjoyed a career on the stage as well. Most notably in the final national tour of Hello, Dolly! With Carol Channing. The Minneapolis Star Tribune lauded him as the Outstanding Director of a Musical of 2007.

Michael Gilch (Music Director, Conductor) is a versatile Asbury Parkbased musician, composer, and arranger. He has played in Broadway pits, Village jazz clubs, and conducted pit orchestras in many NYC/NJ regional theatres and universities. Kara Leigh (Asst. Musical Director) Kara Leigh is a well-known music director all throughout New Jersey. Her work extends to our neighbors in New York and Pennsylvania. She has been teaching and music directing for over 15 years and has musically directed, conducted, and performed in over 200 shows. He was the Executive Director at Algonquin Arts Theatre in Manasquan, NJ for six years. While there, he produced over 30 main stage Broadway style shows such as the New Jersey premiere of Spamalot starring Robert Johanson, Joseph...., Tuesdays with Morrie, The 1940s Radio Hour, The Music Man, Always, Patsy Cline starring Emmy Award Winner Sally Struthers and Carter Calvert, Kids Say the Darndest Things starring Patrick Cassidy, My Fair Lady, The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee, Shrek, The King & I, Annie Get Your Gun and South Pacific.

As a composer he collaborated with the late science fiction writer Ray Bradbury on the musical adaptation of Mr. Bradbury's short story, The Day It Rained Forever. He also had the great fortune to work with the late fiction novelist Mary Higgins Clark on an adaptation of her new children's book, The Magical Christmas Horse, composing the music and co-writing the lyrics with playwright Cynthia Mitchell Payne, and the show had a successful run at Algonquin Arts Theatre. At Cherry County Playhouse in co-composed Muskegon, MI, he music and lyrics along playwright/co-lyricist/director Bill Castellino and co-composer/co-lyricist

Christopher McGovern for Crash Club, a new hip-hop musical for teens that was choreographed by Emmy Award winning and Tony Award nominated choreographer Joshua Bergasse. He was the composer and co-lyricist for Queen Esther, which he co-wrote with playwright Lenora Conway.

As an actor he has been seen in the lead role of Giuseppe in The Gondoliers, the role of Florian in Princess Ida, the role of Bill Bobstay in H.M.S. Pinafore and as a pirate in The Pirates of Penzance starring Hal Linden, all at City Center in New York City. He was featured in The Presidents starring Rich Little and directed by Bill Castellino, first at the Helen Hayes Performing Arts Center and then at TheatreFest in Montclair, NJ. The show was later taped for TV at The Paris Theatre, Las Vegas and subsequently aired on PBS. As a commercial actor, he has appeared in several TV commercials for such companies as Letgo, YOPA (England), Benjamin Moore Paints, Office Depot among others.

As a songwriter he wrote the music with lyricist Nick De Biase for two songs for Centaur Records: "Every Time You're Near' performed by Tony Award winner Alice Ripley on the CD, Utopia and "Never Letting Go' sung by Elsa Raven on the CD, Dance With Angels. He also wrote the music with lyricist Bill Castellino for Tony Award nominee Rebecca Luker's recording of "Fine' which is featured on her album, Leaving Home, produced by Christopher McGovern.

As a singer he made appearances around the globe from 2001 to 2018 with the famous disco group Village People, officially replacing David Hodo as the Construction Worker in the group in 2013. He is a proud member of ASCAP, SAG-AFTRA, Actors Equity Association and Dramatist Guild. He earned his BA in Theatre at Pepperdine University in Malibu, CA, teaches voice and produces music in his home where he resides with his husband Christopher Verdi.

Bob Angelini (Managing Director, APTCo Co-Founder) Bob is thrilled to be able to bring professional theater back to Asbury Park. Serena Soffer (Associate Producer) is a versatile artist. (triple threat as they say) A Broadway performer, choreographer, dance educator and yogi! She has worked extensively all over the world. She was first inspired by her mother, Eva, a performing contortionist in the early 1930's in the German circus. Serena's professional performing career began at the young age of ten, where she began working with multiple legends, including Ray Bolger (the Scarecrow in The Wizard of Oz), Gregory Hines, Donald O'Connor (Singing in the Rain) and Jane Krakowski (NBC's 30 Rock). Just google kids!! In her teens, she received a full scholarship to the New York Academy of Theatrical Arts which began her journey with her classical ballet training. Her Broadway credits include Assistant Choreographer and featured performer in Footloose. Radio City music Hall Bernadette Peters Live, featured dancer in Broadway Bares directed by Jerry Mitchell. 3 years in the National and European tour of Phantom of the Opera. Assistant choreographer to and dancer in the movie Rock of Ages starring Tom Cruise. Serena choreographed "Panic! At The Disco!" tour Nothing Rhymes With Circus. For many years she was on the faculty of Broadway Dance Center. She has danced in many national commercials, such as McDonald's, Intel and E-Trade. She appeared on ABC's All My Children, as well as Saturday Night Live as a "Weekend Update' dancer, The Late Night Show with David Letterman and The Rosie O'Donnell Show. She choreographed the Super Bowl wellremembered Chevy Car Wash, Snickers, Axe Body Spray, Dove Soap (starring Lea Michelle from Glee) and the famous AT&T Grand Central station flash mob commercials. After dealing with a few dance injuries Serena became much more dedicated to her yoga practice and spirituality. Learning to chant Nam-Myoho-Renge-Kyo and the study of Yogic philosophy came a decade before Serena gave up her dancer's "ego" and intertwined the body, mind and spirit through her Yoga practice. In 1998 her beloved mom died 2 weeks before the opening night of Footloose. Life definitely took on even a deeper meaning for wholeness and oneness. Serena spent an entire summer living at Ananda Ashram in upstate New York and soon after received her Yoga Teacher Training certification at Laughing Lotus in NYC, where she was a senior teacher for several years. Miss Serena is an encyclopedia of knowledge and spirit that will never feel as though her cup is overflowing with too much passion! 


