INSTRUCTIONS FOR CIRCULATORS OF DON GRAY'S NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR COUNTY CLERK

- 1. You must be a US Citizen and over the age of 18 to pass petitions. A 17 year old may pass petitions as long as they turn 18 before or on the same day as the 2026 General Election, November 3, 2026.
- 2. You may pass Don's petition anywhere in Sangamon County starting August 5, 2026.
- 3. You may not circulate petitions for more than one political party.
- 4. You must personally witness all signatures made on Don's petitions.
- 5. You may sign your own petition for Don if you are a registered voter in Sangamon County.
- 6. Petitions with fewer than 10 names DO COUNT. If you are not able to fill a petition, send in the partial list. Each signature counts!
- 7. If you learn a signature in not valid, do not worry. Bad signatures do not knock out other good signatures or invalidate a petition. HOWEVER, known bad signatures should be brought to our attention, so that they can be officially deleted.
- 8. DO NOT number the petition page.
- 9. You must sign as the circulator of the petition before a Notary Public licensed in Illinois and the Notary Public must affix his/her seal or stamp. Most banks and libraries will notarize free of charge. The Election Office and Republican Headquarters will notarize free of charge.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PETITION SIGNERS

- 1. A signer must be a registered voter of Sangamon County. Please note that the person need not have voted in a previous Republican or Democratic Primary or may not have voted at all. **The signer only needs to be a registered voter of Sangamon County to sign**.
- 2. A signer must sign their name as they are registered to vote. For example, William E. Jones, not Bill Jones.
- 3. DO NOT allow signers to use ditto marks for any part of an address. Standard abbreviations may be used in writing the voter address. For example, St. for Street.
- 4. The signer must use the address where they are registered to vote. Post Office box or work addresses are not acceptable.
- 5. Signers MAY NOT sign petitions for candidates of more than one political party.
- 6. Signers cannot sign another member of their family's name on the petition.
- 7. Signers can only sign once for a candidate.
