

Beginner-Intermediate Handbuilding and Wheel Pottery with Barbara Goretzky: 7:00-9:30 Mondays, Sept 24 to Dec 3 (8 weeks, no class Oct 8): \$230.00

An introductory class to hand building with clay as well as making pots on the wheel. Slab, coil and extruded form will be explored, and basic forms on the wheel. Combining of hand built and wheel-thrown forms may be included as well. Designed for new students as well as those who have some clay experience. Price includes glazes and firings, and one bag of clay. Additional clay can be purchased separately. (details provided upon registration). *REGISTER BY Sept 21*

Block Printing Christmas Cards with Barbara Goretzky: 6:30-9:00 Wednesdays, November 7 and 14: \$75.00

Create your own Christmas designs and print your own cards and tags! Block printing, one of the oldest forms of image reproduction, involves carving a linoleum/rubber block with tools, applying ink, and printing onto paper, fabric or other surfaces. In this two-evening workshop, the basics of carving will be taught, as well as composition and reversing an image. A great workshop for beginners, but more advanced techniques will be taught for those with experience. All supplies and tools included.

Basket Weaving: Egg basket Workshop With Beth Crabb: Saturday, Sept 22 9:00-5:00 and Sunday Sept 23 10:00-12:00: \$125.00

Students will work to create an egg basket in this two day workshop. Basic weaving techniques will be taught and students can expect to complete the project in class time. A juried member of the Saskatchewan Craft Council, Beth started weaving in 1991 at Crete Nebraska, and learned Willow weaving in Saskatchewan. She is largely self-taught, and enjoys creating her own designs. Her work in watercolour and clay influence the development of her weavings. Her weavings are in collections across Canada. Beth's classes are focused on fun, learning, and exploring your colour and textural choices, while developing your skills as a basket weaver.

Beginner Watercolour Painting with Beth Gaffney: Saturday, Oct 20, and Sunday Oct 21, 10:00-4:00 on both days: \$175.00

Join well-known Regina-based Watercolour Artist Beth Gaffney for this intensive two day introduction to watercolour painting. Beth will take the group step-by-step through colour mixing and painting technique exercises, and then students will complete a painting using those skills. All supplies included.
