Adult Workshops and Classes



Eco-Printing with Bonnie Macnab: Saturday, September 21, 10:30-3:30 \$75.00, materials included. register by September 19

Join Artist Bonnie Macnab for this printing workshop using natural materials on watercolor paper. You will start the day with a walk to collect foliage, berries and flowers for printing. You can expect to leave the class with several sheets of paper to make cards, postcards or a journal. Eco-Printing is an interaction between mordant, plant material, and the process of drawing out the image of a plant's identity onto a porous surface such as paper and fibre with the help of pressure, steam, and/or simmering. The alchemy of this process is fascinating.

Basket Weaving Workshop With Beth Crabb: Saturday, Oct 26 9:00-4:00 \$85.00, plus \$30.00 materials fee payable to instructor). register by October 18 Weave a ribbed melon-type basket with Moose Jaw artist Beth Crabb. You will use dyed reed, a wooden hoop for the rim, and may incorporate yarn or seagrass for textural interest. There will be a wide variety of colours to choose from, in the reed and the yarn. Project is suitable for anyone with average hand strength. Please bring your lunch, and the following tools: scissors, tape measure, pencil, an awl or nutpick if you have one, a dishpan type tub, an old towel, and a plastic/vinyl apron.



Beginner-Intermediate Wheel Pottery with Barbara Goretzky: 7:00-10:00 Tuesdays, Sept 17 to November 19 (10 weeks) \$275.00 register by September 13

Join Barbara Goretzky for a ten week pottery throwing session. We will focus on successful centring and developing a variety of functional pottery shapes. There will be various exercises to complete with an emphasis on increasing your throwing abilities. Surface decoration and glazing will round out this session with completed pottery pieces to take home. *Fee includes one box of clay, and glazing/firing costs for one box of clay*

Intermediate Pottery with Dee Funk: All about Teapots and things with Lids 7:00-10:00 Mondays, September 23 to November 25 (8 weeks, no class Oct 14 or Nov 11) \$260.00. register by September 13 This session of intermediate pottery will be a project-based class.

Learn to throw teapot vessels, spots and handles. This class will require some out-of-class commitments, and the course fee includes a key for studio access. *Fee includes one box of clay, and glazing/firing costs for one box of clay*



Beginner Acrylic Painting with Barbara Goretzky: 7:00-10:00 Mondays, Sept 16 to Dec 2 (10 weeks, no class Oct 14 or Nov 11) \$250.00. register by September 13

Feeling ready to move beyond paint nights? Barbara Goretzky will lead a ten week acrylic painting session. We will begin with an introduction into acrylic painting and continue each week with a new painting exercise. You will apply these new techniques in completing a large canvas for your home, from the beginning sketches to the final attaching of the hanging wire. Some supplies/materials included. Information for purchasing remaining supplies will be provided upon registration, as price will vary based on personal project choices.
