- i. Admission of the Selected candidates will be held on 16th July 2019.
Candidates are required to report for Interview cum Seat Counselling at 8.30 am

St. John's Medical College**

ii. Admission protocol:

1. Candidate reports to the HELP DESK and collects the Option Entry Form.
2. Candidate submits the Original Documents at the College Council Room.
3. Candidate fills up the Option Entry Form based on the availability of seats displayed outside the ADC's Office and meets the Counselling Team in the ADC's office for selection of available seats.
4. Candidate pays the fees and fulfills all the admission formalities.
5. Candidate meets the Director for the final approval of his/her admission.



Original documents to be submitted for Admission:

Candidates must submit the following Original documents and one photocopies of the documents to the Academic section.

- a. 10th Standard marks card
- b. 12th Standard marks card
- c. B.Sc., MLT (all years) marks card, B.Sc., MLT degree certificate
- d. For Catholic candidates only : Baptism certificate and/or a letter from Parish priest stating that the candidate is a *bona fide* member of the parish
- e. SC/ST/OBC certificate for applicable candidates
- f. Transfer Certificate
- g. Migration Certificate
- h. Eligibility Certificate (Refer below for details)

iii. **Eligibility Certificate (to be procured before the Admission Process)**

Selected Candidates with Bachelors' degree from Universities other than **Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences** (RGUHS), Karnataka are requested to submit the eligibility Certificate. Failure to produce the Eligibility Certificate and original documents as required by the Academic Section within the stipulated time and without the written permission of the Director, will be considered **NON-ACCEPTANCE** of selection.

- iv. The candidate shall pay the fees by 4.00 pm on the day of admission. Any candidate failing to pay the fees by 4.00 pm on the day of the admission will be forfeit the seat.
- v. The admission granted is considered "**PROVISIONAL**" until all the original supporting documents submitted are approved by the RGUHS, Karnataka.
- vi. The candidates are required to place an order for the white laboratory coat / apron on the day of the admission at the Counter opposite to Accounts Section.
