It really helps if you've seen the original as this will make more sense as there are references throughout. But even without having seen the first one, this one stands on its own.

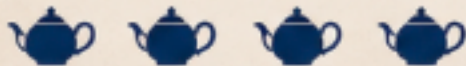
Like most sequels, because you've already been introduced to the characters, they won't seem as "fresh" as they were the first time around.
