Big Rock Township Senior / Disabled Transportation Program

Big Rock Township board has begun a pilot transportation program to provide seniors and disabled residents with a transportation option to travel to local doctor appointments, shopping, and other important needs.

Township seniors over age 65, and any resident with a disability that does not allow them to hold an Illinois Driver License to operate a vehicle is eligible to use this program.

Application for Senior / Disabled Transportation program

Transportation is available to eligible residents from their home to any location within the boundaries of:

North: Rt. 38; East: Rt. 31; South: Baseline/Galena Rd; West: Somonauk/W. Sandwich Rd.
Note: Travel to Rush Copley Medical Center in Aurora is also included.

Eligible residents pay a \$5 copay (\$10 round trip) to the driver with a limit of four (4) rides per month per resident. Residents ineligible for the senior/disabled program, or travelling outside of the program boundaries will be responsible for paying the full cost of the ride.
