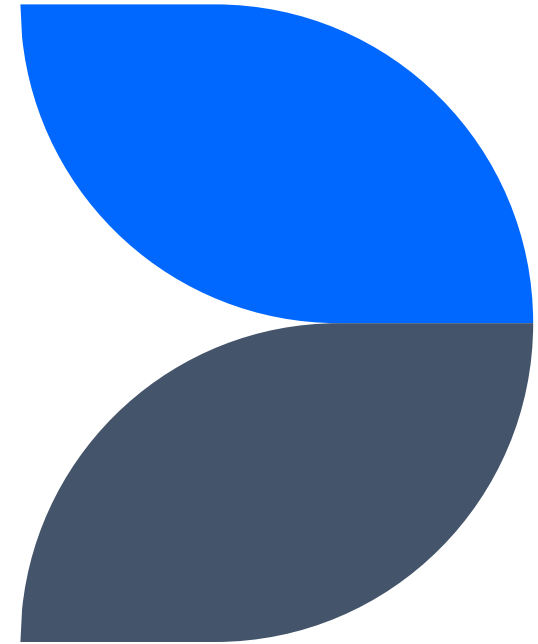
Our Statement of Faith is divided into two sections: essentials and convictions.

Essentials

GOD

God is love. He is powerful and perfect - the Creator of all things. He has existed in relationship with Himself for eternity as one God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Each person of the Trinity possesses equal power and authority.

THE FATHER

The Father is kind and gracious. He is all powerful, all knowing, ever-present, unchanging, completely worthy of our trust, and above all, holy. It is in Him that we live, move and exist. The Father is good, loving, compassionate, and faithful to His children and His promises.

THE SON

Jesus Christ, the Son, is completely human and completely God. He was conceived through the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He lived a perfect life, and was crucified under Pontius Pilate. He died on the cross as the all-sufficient sacrifice for human sin. Later, He rose from the dead, defeating death, and ascended into heaven, where He now reigns over all powers and authorities. His victory over death and sin enables us to have eternal life.

THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit's presence assures us of our relationship with Christ until His return. He guides us into all truth and glorifies Jesus as Lord. He brings conviction of sin, God's righteousness, and the coming judgment. He is with us as our Comforter, and gives spiritual gifts that make us more like Christ.

THE BIBLE

The Bible is God's Word to all people. It was composed by human authors under the supernatural guidance of the Holy Spirit. Because it was inspired by God, the Bible should be believed in all that it teaches, trusted in all it promises, and obeyed in all it requires.

HUMANS

Humans are made in the image of God and are the supreme object of His creation. Every human is uniquely created, possesses dignity, and is worthy of respect and love. Humans were made to experience relationship with God but became separated from Him through sinful disobedience.

ETERNITY

God has “set eternity in the hearts” of humans. Humans will exist for eternity with God through forgiveness and salvation in Christ or be separated from God for rejecting Him. To be separated from God is Hell. To be with God is Heaven. Both Heaven and Hell are real places of existence. Ultimately, followers of Jesus will spend eternity in a New Heaven & New Earth with the Lord.

SALVATION

The blood of Jesus Christ, shed on the cross after He lived a perfect life in our place, provides the only way of salvation through the forgiveness of sin. Salvation occurs when people place their faith in the life, death, and resurrection of Christ as sufficient payment for their sin. Salvation is a gift from God, and it cannot be earned through human effort.

THE CHURCH

The Church is a global community of people – past, present, & future – who are unified through faith in Christ. The Church is the body of Christ and is committed to the teachings of Christ, to fellowship with one another, to celebrating the Lord’s supper, and to prayer. It seeks to bring the Gospel to the world. The Church is organized into local churches, where worship, love, sacrifice, and faithfulness are embodied in real human community.

Convictions

BAPTISM

We know that Jesus was baptized, and we believe His present-day disciples should be, as He instructed. The act of baptism does not save though. Christ saves. One who answers the Spirit's call to follow Jesus should then be baptized, as it signifies what Christ has done by cleansing the sinner from sin, bringing union with Christ, and bringing the new believer into the Church.

THE LORD'S SUPPER

On the night He was betrayed, Jesus instituted a practice we know as Communion or the Lord's Supper. We believe the Lord's Supper is a regular commitment Jesus's followers make to remember His death, and also a renewal of our faith that mysteriously encourages us by His presence and joins us to one another.

SEX & MARRIAGE

God designed sex for marriage relationships, and that God established marriage as a lifelong, exclusive union between one biological man and one biological woman. God calls all His people to honor Him with their sexual activity as taught in the Scriptures.

We believe that marriage before the Lord as modeled in the Bible is different and distinct from legal, governmental marriage.

THE SANCTITY OF LIFE

Human life is sacred from conception to its natural end. Therefore, it is imperative that we have concern for the physical and spiritual needs of our fellow human beings during the whole lifespan.

Our conviction on the sacredness of life leads us to advocate for: adoption over abortion, comfort over euthanasia, and healthcare autonomy over forced procedures and/or medications.
