

XPEL Headlight Protection Film (Clear and Tinted)

XPEL Headlight Protection Film is a XPEL Headlamp Protection Film has a proprietary outer skin that is nearly impossible to scuff or scratch, and an inner layer that bonds to lenses and evens out any surface imperfections. It's thick enough to handle direct stone strikes, but still lets headlamp heat dissipate naturally.

Directions:

- 1. Clean your headlights and remove any bugs and/or debris before applying XPEL Headlight Protection Film.
- 2. Mix 1 quart of water with 3 or 4 drops of dishwashing liquid in a spray bottle. Shake bottle once both solutions are in the bottle.
- **3.** Spray the soap and water solution on the headlamps.
- **4.** Take your headlight film and peel the backing paper from the film and wet the adhesive size with the soap/water solution.
- **5.** Align the headlight film with the headlight and begin to fit the headlight film to the surface. Stretch and application technique may vary depending your vehicles headlights
- **6.** Squeegee the soap/water solution from beneath the film using a squeegee or application card.
- 7. Make sure all fluid is squeegeed out and there are no lifting edges.
 - **a.** If you have an edge that will not stick, we recommend using a diluted 70% Isopropyl Alcohol in a spray bottle. 50/50 mixture of water and alcohol
 - **b.** Take the alcohol mixture in the spray bottle and spray the edges where the film will not stick and use your squeegee to press down on the film
