- You will need a good understanding of English to complete your consultations and test.

What will the course cover?

- Understand the contra-indications and contra-actions that affect or restrict the treatments
- Understand how to provide aftercare and homecare advice

What do I need, for this course?

You will also need a selection of models to conduct your case studies and a video unit to record your case studies. Case studies must be live and must show you doing two each of the following treatments:

- Cherry angioma or Milia
- Pigmentation
- Skin Tags
- Verrucae or Warts

What is the cost of the course? Are there any additional costs?

How long is the course?
