Programme: Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing (RQF)

Who is the course for?

This qualification is for complete beginners or existing hairdressers, no previous experience required to attend. You will develop your skills to a high level of occupational ability to enable you to perform mobile, home and salon services.

What are the entry requirements?

- No prior experience is required for this course, and it is suitable for complete beginners through to learners that just wish to upskill their previous certification
- You will also need a good understanding of English to complete your assignments and exams

Will I be expected to complete work in my own time? (Home-study, practice & case studies)

Structured, supported self-study will be expected from all learners. You will be required to complete assignments as evidence of knowledge & understanding. You will also be required to attend a final practical exam. Theory and all practical will be conducted at the centre to cover the course units.

What do I need, for this course?

SDT will provide your manual and log assessment book. You will need a tint bowl, tint brush, clips, combs, brushes and cutting scissors. We can provide you with a letter to obtain trade prices from hairdressing suppliers. You also need access to a computer or laptop and a camera on your phone, and a **professional black top or polo shirt, black trousers and black closed shoes (No Trainers). You will need to bring a model with you for your final practical exam.**

How long is the course?

This is a part-time course. One day a week. Monday or Tuesday 9.30am – 2.30pm for five months. Evening Classes are one evening a week. Mondays 6.30pm to 9.30pm for ten months. We like to ensure that you have plenty of hands-on experience, so if you feel that you require extra practical sessions, this can be arranged for you. You will be required to submit your assignments, attend your practical sessions and your exam day to complete the course and gain your qualification.
