SCOPE OF WORK

Runway PCL Lighting Design & Apron Resurfacing Design

1. General Background:

This scope of work consists of engineering & design.

- Runway Lighting System Replacement. To include Elevated LED Runway Edge Lights with Isolation Transformer, Elevated LED Threshold/End Lights with Isolation Transformer, Constant Current Regulator, Lighting Controller Panel, Radio Controller, Vault Improvements, Electrical Conduit to protect wiring, Etc.
- Apron Resurfacing Design. To include survey and design specifications for the complete rehabilitation by replacement of Parking Apron 1A. Apron 1A in 375 ft by 225 ft or 9,375 Sq. Yds. of asphalt surface. There are no unique features on the field. Natural features are desert scrub brush and sandy soils with minor washes around rock formations. This project will replace an already existing apron area and does not encroach on any areas outside of the existing airport paved surfaces.

To support the Chemehuevi Valley Airport (49X) located on the Chemehuevi Indian Reservation on the Western Shore of Lake Havasu.

2. Specific Requirements:

Coordinate all work with the Tribal Planning Office Director, following the Tribe's Airport Layout Plan. 60%, 90% & final Designs are to be provided as the project progresses. Coordination meetings shall be held within 10 days of each preliminary design phase milestone to gather feedback and adjust areas of concern. Deliverables include Final Design Plan for Runway Lighting System, Final Design Plan for Apron Resurfacing Plan, Electronic CAD Files for each.
