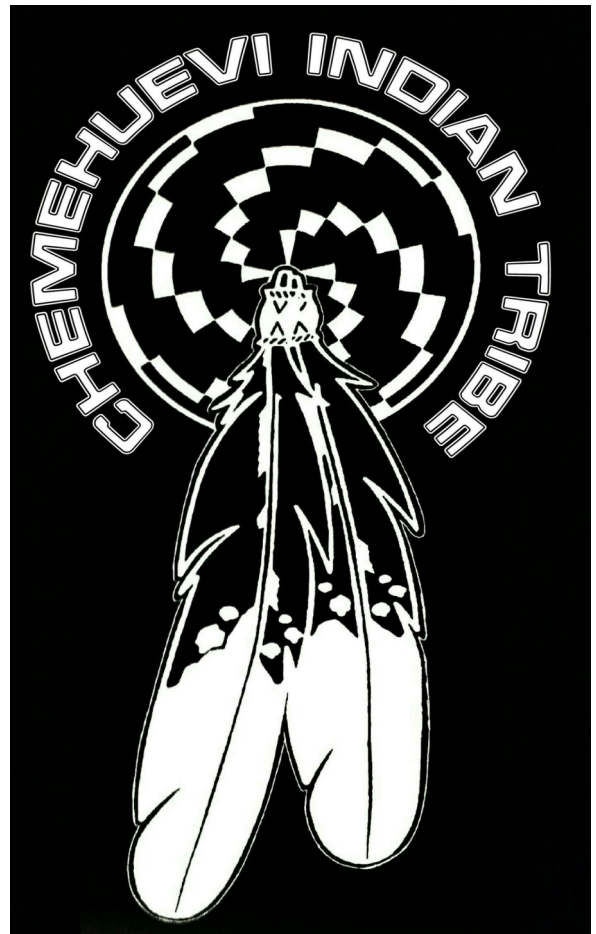

WHAT DO WE DO?

The TERO program enforces tribally enacted American Indian preference law, which ensures American Indians gain their rightful share of employment, training, contracting, subcontracting, and business opportunities occurring on or near reservations.

2

The Chemehuevi Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO), by virtue of a contractual agreement with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC), is authorized to interview and counsel individuals with potential employment discrimination charges. The TERO employees address draft charges of alleged violations of Title VII, file complaints with the EEOC and attempt to resolve the charge by mediation within 30 days.

Fees for services rendered by the Clerk of the Court are payable in advance; all payments must be in the form of a personal check, cashier's check or money order and must be made payable to the Chemehuevi Indian Tribal Court. The following Court fees have been established by the Chemehuevi Indian Tribal Council (Resolution 25-7-28-B) in accordance with Rule 8 of the Rules of Pleading, Practice and Procedure of the Tribal Court of the Chemehuevi Indian Tribe. The Resolution states "WHEREAS, the Tribal Court fee for non-tribal applicants is \$50.00".¹

Maikwas membership my name is Joseph Jimenez I am the new Farm manager with Chemehuevi Agriculture Department. I have background in water systems and maintenance, along with indigenous tree cultivation and seed propagation. Some of the current projects we have going in the department are planting pumpkins, 4 different types of watermelon's and gourds. The department has also activated one of the greenhouses to grow all melons and gourds. Currently we are in development of a tree nursery here on the reservation which will be located next to the Agriculture/EPA office. We hope to provide willow cottonwood and mesquite to the US Forestry Service for wild fire restoration and the community. We also hope to break ground on three new tree lines one for pomegranates, dwarf lemons trees and moringa trees. Feel free to stop by the office or give us a call if you have any suggestions on plants or trees that the membership would like to see in our agriculture field. Our goal here is to provide organic grown fruits and vegetables to our tribe and community and we would like to hear the membership's thoughts and ideas.

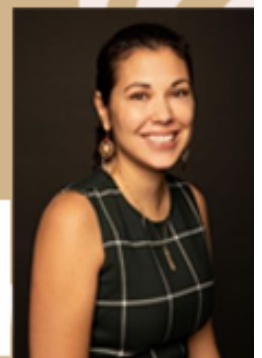

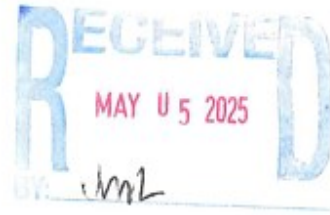
