

TERO TRIBAL EMPLOYMENT RIGHTS OFFICE

WHAT DO WE DO?

- The TERO program enforces tribally enacted American Indian preference law, which ensures American Indians gain their rightful share of employment, training, contracting, subcontracting, and business opportunities occurring on or near reservations.
- The Chemehuevi Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO), by virtue of a contractual agreement with the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC), is authorized to interview and counsel individuals with potential employment discrimination charges. The TERO employees address draft charges of alleged violations of Title VII, file complaints with the EEOC and attempt to resolve the charge by mediation within 30 days.

Tapitsap: Lit. trans., that which is knotted or tied.

Messages were delivered to designated persons, usually heads of other clans, by runners carrying knotted strips of yucca. Once the message was delivered, the recipient untied it and the runner returned the string to the sender, often carrying a new knotted string with a new message. Members of "runner societies" were most trustworthy and it was understood that their journeys were not to be impeded. Due to their tirelessness, they were deemed other-worldly.

Hello Tribal Members,

The weather here on the rez is cool nights, and warm days.

On November 6, the Code Enforcement Department perticipated in a Sensitity Training that was hosted at the Chemehuevi Cultural Center by June Leivas and Briget Sandate. The information on the Chemehuevi's was interesting and I think its important for everyone to know. Espececilly for tribal members and employees of the tribe. Great Job Guys!

On November 7, the department worked with the US Fish and Wildlife Department on a Big Horn Sheep gather in the Chemehuevi Mountians. Two Ewes were caught, blood tested, nasal swabbed, measured, inspected for injuries, and released back to the herd. They were also outfitted with a GPS collar and an ear tag. This will help with montering the herd and health of the Big Horn Sheep.

The Burro Round Up is underway, 96 Burros have been rounded up. They are on their way to Ridgecreast California to enter the BLM Wildhorse and Burro Program.
