The overwhelming majority of COVID-19 cases – nearly 96% percent – are among the unvaccinated or partially vaccinated, according to County’s Department of Public Health data. Out of 26,232 COVID-19 cases, 25,161 were among the unvaccinated or partially vaccinated and 1,071 were among the fully vaccinated. Know What to Expect at Your Child's K- 12 School or Child Care Program. 8/3/21 <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/groups/expect-school-child-care.html>

- Universal recommendation of indoor masking for **all** teachers, staff, students, and visitors to **K-12 schools**, regardless of vaccination status.
- Children should return to full-time in-person learning in the fall **with** layered prevention strategies in place.

As of Tuesday, July 27th **Fully Vaccinated** people **wear a mask** in public indoor settings in areas of substantial or high transmission.

- Added information that fully vaccinated people might choose to wear a mask regardless of the level of transmission, particularly if they are immunocompromised or at increased risk for severe disease from COVID-19, or if they have someone in their household who is immunocompromised, at increased risk of severe disease or not fully vaccinated.
- Added a recommendation for fully vaccinated people who have a known exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 to be tested 3-5 days after exposure, and to wear a mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until they receive a negative test result.
- CDC recommends universal indoor masking for all teachers, staff, students, and visitors to schools, regardless of vaccination status.
- Continue to follow any applicable federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations.

National

The President announced Wednesday, July 29th that all Federal employees and Federal Contract workers show proof of full vaccination or test regularly 2-3 times a week. Mr. Biden said small- and medium-sized businesses will be eligible to be reimbursed for offering employees paid time off to get themselves or family members vaccinated. President Biden called on state and local governments to use COVID-19 relief funds to give \$100 to residents who get vaccinated. The White House is asking states, localities and territories to use leftover funding from the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan passed in March to cover the cash payments.
