Social Distancing:

- 1-2 extra sets of clothing (seasonally appropriate; shirt, pants/shorts, underwear, socks, 1 pair of shoes).

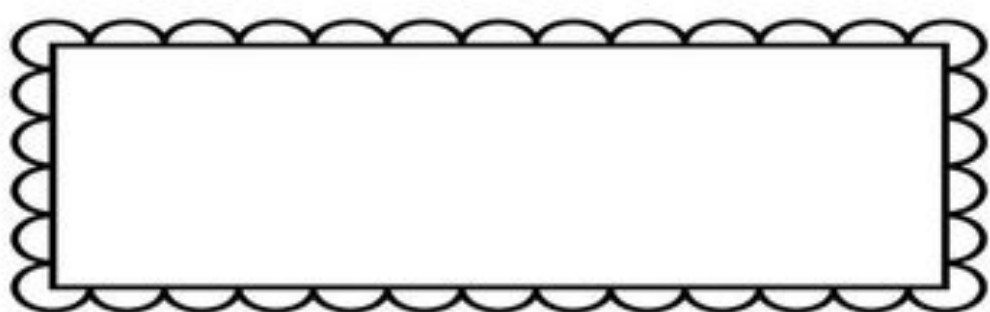


- Reusable water bottle – Labeled with child's name.

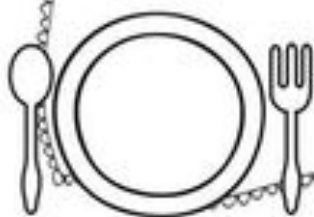
