## Classroom Sanitization

- Frequently sanitizing toys throughout the day using 3 bin sanitization system.
- Restriction of porous toys in the classroom
- safe storing of bedding in child's pillowcase/tote bag

## Things to Remember

- Store bought food only for special gatherings
- Please bring in 5 fitted crib sheets. As well as 5 blankets each Monday in a vinyl or plastic tote bag. The tote bag will be sanitized upon arrival. Each day we will send home the sheet and blanket that was used at nap time that day.
- Please No backpacks
- If your child arrives in rain/snow boots please bring an extra pair of shoes to change into
- Please make sure all items are labeled with your child's name. This includes hats, coats, sweaters, etc.
- No Onesie style outfits (for potty training purposes)





## Supplies Needed

## Classroom Social distancing



- Classroom is staged to promote social distancing and individual play areas
