





Today, we face a historic turning point. We can fight for a government that defends our freedoms, or we can turn a blind eye and descend into despotism. Already, there is a fierce assault on our liberties. We can feel the tides of aggression towards both people of faith and the free market.

Our Constitution was purposely established to limit the size of government. Article I, Section 8, empowers Congress to do only seventeen things—eight concerning national defense, six with respect to commerce (securing the

DEFENDING FREEDOM

rights of citizens and businesses), and the remainder about territories. Anything else is government overreach. In addition, the Ninth Amendment clarifies: "The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people." Have our elected representatives and appointed judges forgotten that government exists to protect, not to grant, our rights?

In securing a limited government, the founders expected that state and local governments would hold a broad range of responsibilities. In this spirit, early Americans entrusted parents, teachers, and school boards to run our education system. Before digital classrooms, standardized tests, and bureaucratic K-12 masterplans were ever conceived, our great nation produced some of the brightest minds in history. The federalist approach to education nourished hearts and minds, formed habits and principles, and created good citizens. This kind of education was not only the duty of parents: it was their right.

Today, however, a behemoth government infringes on almost every area of our lives. Consider how the Carter Administration established a one-size-fits-all Department of Education. Since then, America's academic rankings and outcomes have been in steep decline.

As the Old Testament reminds us, "My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge." Even with advances in business, transportation, and technology, we can not compensate for a lack of reasoning skills and moral knowledge.


In the face of these challenges, we must educate voters about the principles of limited, constitutional government. We must contend for the return of decision-making power back to the states and local districts. We must protect a delicate system of checks and balances, and refute the claims that the Constitution is an evolving or "living document." Truth does not change. We can not reinterpret the Constitution to mean whatever we want it to mean.

Consider the first paragraph of the Declaration of Independence, with its reference to the "Laws of Nature and of Nature's God." To acknowledge "Nature's God" is to affirm that God has written the moral law on every human heart, on every page of Scripture, and in the Natural Law visible all throughout history. This same Creator God, the Declaration continues, has made humankind equal and endowed us with "certain inalienable rights." Our most precious rights—Life, Liberty, the pursuit of Happiness—are endowed by the Creator, not by the government. This idea is the source of our greatness.

In our words, morals, and actions, we must remind politicians that we are a self-governing people. It's a tremendous responsibility, but I believe that greathearted men and women can restore this nation. Our families and our country are worth the effort and sacrifice. I am reminded of the closing phrase in the Declaration of Independence, in which fifty-six signers "mutually pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes, and our sacred honor." The alternative, in the flaming words of Samuel Adams, is almost unthinkable: "If you love wealth better than liberty... Crouch down and lick the hands which feed you. May your chains set lightly upon you...."


All power of government comes by our consent. No bureaucrat, czar, or official can revoke our freedom of religion, freedom of speech, or freedom to educate our children as self-governed citizens. These and other rights are our hard-won heritage, enshrined in our brilliant, enduring Constitution.

It's painfully clear to us that African Americans today are grappling with challenges. monumental Unemployment rates are nearly double the national average, a staggering literacy rate of just 17%, a poverty rate three times that of whites, and a homelessness rate four times that of whites—these statistics tell a harrowing story. As if that weren't enough, many continue to perceive African Americans as dangerous, criminally inclined and untrustworthy, adding yet another layer to their struggles.

We must confront the critical questions head-on:

- 1. Is this disparity due to slavery?
- 2. Is this disparity due to racism?

Many on the left insist that the answer is undoubtedly both, but we can't help but wonder: is this assertion truly accurate? In our groundbreaking new book, How to Stop Racism in America, we embark on a thrilling journey through history, rewinding back to the time of slavery to explore the incredible journey of African Americans. Our mission is to unearth the root causes of their plight and unveil real solutions to these pressing issues. Victors or Victims?

the Emancipation Proclamation, many freed slaves made bold moves from the countryside, where they had been forced into labor, into the cities. When we examine African Americans in the 1920s, we don't find a group of oppressed victims shackled by their past; instead, we uncover a community of oppressed victors! Despite the relentless oppression inflicted by Democrats and their Jim Crow laws, along with the horrors of lynchings, segregation, and racism and discrimination all which are far worse than anything today, African Americans were not merely surviving; they were thriving and that too against all odds. The cornerstone of their success was a robust family structure, anchored by a father. Moreover, since they unwelcome in traditional schools. their commitment to homeschooling resulted in an impressive literacy rate of about 70%.

But there's more! They were willing to take the same jobs as whites for half the pay, leading even the most racist employers to hire them, as the allure of green—money—eclipsed the color of one's skin.

As a result, African Americans acquired new trade skills and reinvested them into their communities, building homes and launching businesses—law practices, banks, dental offices, medical practices, contracting firms. White dollars flowed into the black community, circulating an astonishing 36 to 100 times before leaving, generating wealth, products, and invaluable skills. Black Wall Street emerged as a beacon of

prosperity, a symbol of resilience and success. While many are familiar with the tragic burning of this vibrant community, few know that it rebounded fully within just two years. African Americans were not mere victims; they were true victors!

But what happened between that glorious era and now?

First, racists devised a new tactic to stifle black prosperity: The Minimum Wage. This law was specifically designed by the KKK and the Democrats to prevent black men from taking white jobs. With the minimum wage law in place, white business owners had no incentive to hire black men because they couldn't pay them less. The origins of the minimum wage are rooted in racism, and today, it continues to act as a barrier to wealth. With the black literacy rate at a mere 17%, black youth struggle to read, write, or perform math at a level necessary for jobs that pay a decent wage of \$15 to \$18 an hour. Consequently, the effective minimum wage for most black youth is zero, thanks to this law.

With this understanding, we cannot ignore the reality that anyone who supports minimum wage laws, like the new California law, is, in effect, perpetuating racism.





- Maximize your Social Security payments. You can start collecting Social Security as early as 62, but your monthly benefits will be larger if you can afford to wait until your full retirement age, between 66 and 67. (Payments will "max out" at age
- · Re-enter the workforce. Going back to work in some capacity is one way to possibly help build retirement resources and delay taking Social Security. If you have a particular area of expertise, and you enjoyed the work you did, you might be able to go back to it on a parttime basis or do some consulting. You could boost your cash flow, and potentially extend your contributions to an IRA and to an employer's retirement plan.
- Cut costs during retirement. Possibly the biggest cost-cutting measure is downsizing - are you willing and able to move to a less expensive area or scale down your current living space? Of course, this is an emotional decision, as well as a financial one, and downsizing

isn't for everyone, but it might be something to at least consider. As for the lesser ways of reducing expenses, take advantage of senior discounts, which are offered in areas, including many entertainment, public transportation, restaurants and establishments. And look for other opportunities, such as cutting out streaming services you don't use.

 Look for more income from your investments. As you get closer to retirement, and even when you do retire, you might want to adjust your investment portfolio to provide you with more income-producing opportunities. However, even as a retiree, you'll want some growth potential in your investments to help keep you ahead of inflation.



Mark Twain (Samuel Clemens) is not usually remembered as a devout Christian. Indeed, his religious beliefs seemed to transition throughout his life. A Protestant in his youth, he dabbled in Deism for a while and then crab-walked back to some form of skeptical relationship with the Bible and its claims. However he may have ended his Earthly journey, there were times when he did not accept the existence of Heaven nor Hell and questioned the immortality of the soul as well as the divinity of Jesus. He recorded in his "Notebook", "If Christ were here, there is one thing he would not be—a Christian." Why? Twain was a cleareyed student of Christian history and wrote in his autobiography, "There is one notable thing about our Christianity: bad, bloody, merciless, moneygrabbing and predatory...ours is a terrible religion." No honest observer can deny that the practice of Christians has often failed to live up to the aspirations of our Christ. But that doesn't mean that we shouldn't keep trying, and Twain seemed to believe this as well.

In a magazine interview less than five years before his death, Twain said, "I will be conceded ... that a Christian's first duty is to God. It then follows, as a matter of course, that it is his duty to carry his Christian code of morals to the polls and vote them. If Christians should vote their duty to God at the polls, they would carry every election and do it with ease.... If the Christians of America could be persuaded to vote God and a clean ticket, it would bring about a moral revolution that would be incalculably beneficent. It would save the country." September 2, 1905

Here, in a nutshell, is the overview of what we need to do to save America. If Christians registered to vote (which they often do not), studied their Bibles (which they rarely do), kept informed about current events (again, not a strong suit of ours), and voted the Bible, "It would save the country." We Christians have what America needs. We owe it to our God, our country, and our families to get involved; and the easiest way to start, is to vote.


