- 2019 Budget vs Actuals
 - Generally spending is on track for the year
 - Barking came under budget by \$44.49
 - Added water monitoring (\$478 per year) as Monarch will no longer pay this amount
- 2020 Budget Planning
 - o 2020 proposed budget does not need to include legal fees for CC&R update costs (see below)
 - Proposed Reserve funding: increase from \$14,000 to \$21,000
 - Total increase of \$50 per household (\$15 for operating expenses & \$35 for reserves)
 - Plan to fully fund reserves over 2 years to spread out budget increases
 - Agreed that yearly budget surpluses will be allocated to reserves to expedite getting reserves to fully funded levels
 - o Budget proposal unanimously approved by board
