What Is ELECTRONIC MEDIA?

- 1. Social Network Sites (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram)
- 2. Text Messaging/Instant Messaging
- 3. Email

- Any staff who wishes to communicate with a student or parent via Electronic Media must first get permission from Administration. A "Request for Authorization to Use Electronic Media" form must be filled out and submitted in order to receive permission. This form can be found on the Employee Page of the Kulanu Website.
- All posts on personal social media must comply with Kulanu's policies concerning confidentiality including the confidentiality of student/client information and the Kulanu Code of Conduct

❖ Violation of Kulanu's policy concerning the use of social media may lead to discipline up to and including termination.

SOCIAL NETWORK SITES:

Staff are prohibited from "friending" any current student and/or parent on any personal social network platform.

❖If a student attempts to "friend you", you should "ignore" that request.

TEXT MESSAGING:

Our preferred mode of communication with students and families is email and/or phone.

Please consider text messaging as a last resort of communication!

Any employee who communicates with a student using text messaging must comply with the following protocol:

- The employee must include at least one of the student's parents/guardians as a recipient on each text message to the student so the student and parent receive the same message.
- When texting with parents, please be sensitive to maintain professional boundaries and properly represent Kulanu
- ❖ If you feel a parent is abusing this mode of communication, please seek guidance from your immediate supervisor.

EMAIL

An employee must include at least one of the student's parents/guardians as a recipient on each email to the student so the student and parent receive the same message.

When sending a group email to students and/or parents, please use the BCC line in order to maintain confidentiality. All posts on personal social media must comply with Kulanu's policies concerning confidentiality including the confidentiality of student/client information and the Kulanu Code of Conduct
