



Re-Opening Vision

Program: Preschool

Targeted Area: EDUCATIONAL INSTRUCTION
<p style="text-align: center;">Low Risk Scenario</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All instruction for both the Monday/Wednesday and Tuesday/Thursday class will take place on site with cohorts no larger than 4 students incorporating social distancing and PPE throughout. One teacher will be assigned for both classes.• In order to alleviate the challenge of requiring young students to socially distance, each student will be assigned an individual desk 6 feet away from their fellow classmates. During collaborative learning such as projects, students will sit 2:2 opposite each other at their own individual desks 6 feet apart from each other.• Students will sit 6 feet apart during circle time.
<p style="text-align: center;">Mid-Level Risk Scenario</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only Monday/Wednesday class will be offered which will occur on site with cohorts no larger than 4 students incorporating social distancing and PPE throughout.• A Tues/Thurs Zoom session will be offered for other students.• In order to alleviate the challenge of requiring young students to socially distance, each student will be assigned an individual desk six feet away from their fellow classmates. During collaborative learning such as projects, students will sit 2:2 opposite each other at their own individual desks 6 feet apart from each other.• Students will sit 6 feet apart during circle time.
<p style="text-align: center;">High Risk Scenario</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All instruction will be provided with remote learning via Zoom.

- Arrangements will be made for material pickup at Kulanu through the Director of TLK in order to allow for distancing. PPE will be required for pickup.
- A basic remote learning training for parents and students will be offered during orientation over Zoom.
- Program time will be 3:00-3:40.

Targeted Area: OPERATIONS

Low Risk Scenario

Program Time: 2:30-4:00 will remain the same

Screening:

- Faculty screenings same as Ed. division: Includes questionnaires and daily temperature check outside the building
- Temperature screening for students will take place as soon as child exits the vehicle.
- One TLK faculty member will be responsible to take temperature and another TLK faculty member will be responsible to record it.
- A TLK faculty member will call parent to pick up their child if their temperature is 100 degrees or above.

Arrival:

Option A-Students Arrive by Car Individually:

Screening will occur inside the vehicle. Once screening is complete and as long as student passes the screening, the classroom assistant will escort the student through the front entrance of 124 McGlynn Place to the classroom located in the backroom (conference room). The teacher will be stationed in the classroom awaiting the arrival of the students. The teacher will direct the student to their seat with an activity prepared. After the child is safely with the teacher, the assistant will repeat the procedure for each student. If the child fails the screening, the child will go back to the parent and the child will not be admitted into the building.

Option B-Students Arrive by Carpool or by Bus

Both the teacher and assistant will escort two students each separately in order to promote social distancing. They will first arrive at the screening. Following the screening, they will be escorted to class in groups of two. Once in the classroom, the teacher will

direct students to their seat with an activity prepared. If any of the students fail the screening, they will not be admitted and the assistant will remain with the student in the outdoor isolation area at 620 until the child is picked up.

Dismissal:

- Students will be dismissed one by one accompanied by the preschool assistant in order to avoid congregating outside during dismissal.
- Dismissal will occur through the back entrance of 124 McGlynn Place.

Attendance:

Student and faculty attendance will be monitored on a daily basis. Students and faculty will be called to assess the reason for the absence and take the necessary steps if the reason is COVID-19 as outlined by health and safety regulations. (Following the same protocol as Ed. division).

Educational Materials

Each student will be provided with their own material kit containing essential preschool materials such as crayons, markers, glue and paint. Materials should not be shared with others.

Bathroom Use:

- Preschool assistant will accompany students to and from the bathroom and socially distance whenever feasible.
- If a student requires close assistance in the bathroom, the preschool assistant will be required to help as the student's safety takes precedence.

Cleaning/Hygiene:

- Manipulatives and surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized between student use. Manipulatives that cannot be sanitized properly will not be used.
- Students will need to be supervised when washing hands in order to ensure it is done properly.
- Students will need to be supervised when using hand sanitizer to prevent ingestion.
- If a child places a toy in his or her mouth, the toy will be set aside to be cleaned by hand using gloves.
- Students will use a soap dispenser and Purell located at 124.

Mid-Level Risk Scenario

Program Time:

2:30-4:00 will remain the same

Screening:

- Faculty screenings same as Ed. division: Includes questionnaires and daily temperature check outside the building
- Temperature screening for students will take place as soon as child exits the vehicle.
- One TLK faculty member will be responsible to take temperature and another TLK faculty member will be responsible to record it.
- A TLK faculty member will call parent to pick up their child if their temperature is 100 degrees or above.

Arrival:

Students will only be allowed to arrive to school by car individually. Screening will occur at arrival while parent waits in the vehicle. Once screening is complete and as long as student passes the screening, the classroom assistant will escort the student through the front entrance of 124 McGlynn Place to the classroom located in the backroom (conference room). The teacher will be stationed in the classroom awaiting the arrival of the students. The teacher will direct student to their seat with an activity prepared. After the child is safely with the teacher, the assistant will repeat the procedure for each student. If the child fails the screening, the child will go back to the parent and the child will not be admitted into the building.

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- Students will use a soap dispenser and Purell located at 124.

High Risk Scenario

Instruction will be provided with remote learning via Zoom.

Targeted Area: GROUP ACTIVITIES

Low Risk Scenario

Snack:

- School will provide snack in pre-packaged bags and distribute to each individual student.
- Faculty need to ensure that students clean their hands before and after eating snack.
- Students may not share snack with each other.

Safety Drills:

- All safety drills will be conducted as normal.
- Same guidelines as the Ed. division in terms of social distancing especially once outside the building.

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- School will provide snack in pre-packaged bags and distribute to each individual student.
- Faculty need to ensure that students clean their hands before and after eating snack.
- Students may not share snack with each other.

Safety Drills:

- All safety drills will be conducted as normal.

- Same guidelines as the Ed. division in terms of social distancing especially once outside the building with extra emphasis on social distancing.

Instruction will be provided with remote learning via Zoom.
