

CAROLYN L. BROWNE MEMORIAL

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Background:

Carolyn L. Browne, daughter of Deacon Major W. and Mrs. Beatrice Pryor Chapman was born May 12, 1940, in Monticello, Georgia. Carolyn was educated through the Chicago Public Schools and attended the Chicago Teachers College. During her marriage, she was blessed to become the mother of three beautiful children, Kimberly, Robert, and Patrick. Carolyn worked for the telephone company in California and later as a stenographer for the Chicago Transit Authority until her retirement. She was a faithful Christian. She was a member of Lilydale First B. C. until her death. While there, she served as a Sunday school teacher, an assistant director of the Sunshine Band, the church clerk typist and on the Mother's Board. Carolyn was also a founding member of the Ulysees Turner and the Edward Eason Memorial Scholarship Funds. She was also pianist for the Sunday School.

Funding for the Carolyn Browne Memorial Scholarship, created in memory of Deacon and Mrs. Chatman's daughter, was generously donated by her daughter, Mrs. Kimberly Davis. This fund exists, independently, within the Ulysees S. Turner Memorial Scholarship Fund. The funds will be provided to individuals who exhibit the characteristics and qualities that Carolyn Browne manifested during her lifetime.

Eligibility:

Applicant must be an active member of the Lilydale First B.C. In addition, applicant must be enrolled as a junior or senior in a college or university in good academic standing. A **typed** essay (400-500 words) must be submitted. Essays should describe educational goals and plans for the future.

Enrollment/Grade Requirement.

A transcript indicating grade point average must be submitted to the committee along with the essay. If an individual's grade point average falls below 3.0, consideration will be given at the discretion of the scholarship committee. Eligibility for scholarships will be determined by the committee through the essay, personal interviews and personal recommendations.

Award Amount:

An applicant may apply for the \$1,000 scholarship to be applied towards tuition, books, fees, or room and board. Previous awardees are ineligible for future consideration. The award amount excludes first time registration and tuition fees.
