The three-story, **5,250 m²** facility was meticulously engineered to create an optimal storage environment for archives and photography collections, protecting them from deterioration caused by temperature fluctuations, humidity, and external pollutants.

The Challenge: Engineering the Perfect Preservation Climate



Cobeal's task was to design and construct a building that could maintain a consistent 19°C (66.2°F) temperature with 35% relative humidity (RH) year-round—a challenge that required advanced engineering, specialized HVAC systems, and airtight construction.

Our team worked with precision and innovation, integrating:

- ✓ Advanced climate control technology to regulate temperature and humidity with exacting accuracy.
- ✓ High-efficiency insulation and air circulation systems to prevent environmental fluctuations.
- ✓ Structural reinforcements designed to protect against seismic activity, ensuring the archives remain secure in any condition.


