

From the Vicar's Desk

At the time of writing this letter we are well into the Lent season. As we journey through the lent, we heard the news of the dastardly killing of innocents who had gathered for worship in Christchurch, New Zealand. As the world came to terms with this heart-rending event, what stood out is the response of its government, media and citizens. Its Prime Minister, Jacinda Ardern, who is the youngest female head of state in the world and gave birth to her first child last year, rallied along with her citizens in an extraordinary show of compassion and solidarity with the victims. Although it is frustrating to think how much terrorism can affect the lives of innocents worldwide, such displays of humanity by the citizens of New Zealand show us how to respond to it. It has been a soothing balm for many of the victims and families who have been scarred for life. When hatred makes demons out of humans, it is such love and courage that makes people truly human. Love and truth can be crucified by hatred and a web of lies. But that will not be the end of it. Love will rise again. The truth that love triumphs over all hate will be plain for all to see.

The death and resurrection of our Lord teaches us about Christian hope. When our Lord was crucified, the world thought that it would be the end of Jesus. His disciples could have given up hope and surrendered to the forces of death and destruction. But Jesus came back to life. He appeared to multitudes and sent his disciples all over the world to be witnesses to his resurrection. Resurrection is the pivotal event that changed the life of the disciples. He turned their despair into hope. From fearful disciples they became fearless witnesses of Jesus' resurrection.

As we journey with Jesus this Lent, may the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus arouse in us the courage to live with hope, to believe in love and to be witnesses to his resurrection.

With this issue we hope to revive our parish newsletter after a long time. Mr. Binu Oommen is helping us in developing the content and publishing it on our website. With the coming of April, we are looking forward to the onset of spring. Very soon all our weekends at church are going to be filled with events. I encourage all our members to be an active part of all the events.
