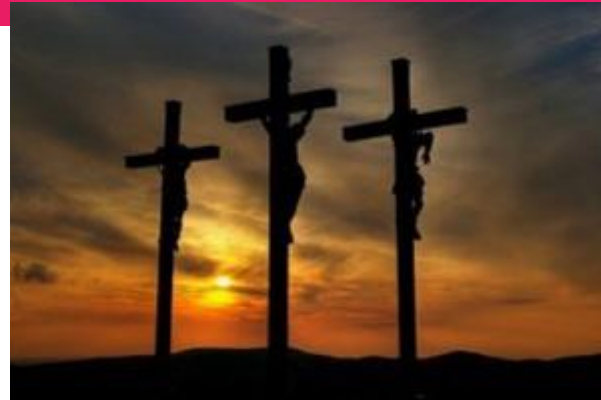

Luke:Ch 23: 44-29

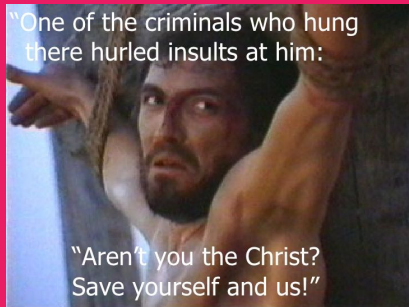
- “Surely this was a righteous Man”
