The Smart Community STEM Camp that he and George Hinckley envisioned was designed primarily to provide young high school students --- especially underserved students including those in public schools --- an opportunity to learn, relish, and be immersed in the world of technology and innovation through meaningful activities. This camp focused on giving students well-targeted opportunities in the realm of scientific learning that were then followed up with mentorship positions in campers' own communities.

After attending summer camp programs, students are equipped to return to their districts to lead middle school clubs spreading exposure, knowledge, and enthusiasm for opportunities in STEM. Thus, the program empowers high school students to further spread their growing skills and understanding beyond themselves, just as Dave chose to share his skills and talents when creating this camp. Over the past four years, the successes of the program have inspired area individuals, universities, corporations, and community organizations to make this cause their cause.

Dave wanted nothing more than for these camp programs to thrive and to expand. He recognized that STEM camp can serve to further student talent in mathematics, science, and engineering and can facilitate strong connections with potential career pathways. It was Dave's vision, hard work, and his dedication along with that of his co-creator, George, that have made this camp a reality.
