2	(WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were duly
3	had:)
4	THE CLERK: Calling case 62-CV-22-418 Brian
5	VanMeveren versus Becky Cole.
6	THE COURT: All right. If counsel would note
7	their appearances, please, starting with Plaintiff.
8	MS. CYLKOWSKI: Good morning, Your Honor.
9	Laurie Cylkowski, C-Y-L-K-O-W-S-K-I. I represent Brian
10	VanMeveren, who is also present seated to my right.
11	THE COURT: All right. Thank you.
12	MR. MAHER: Timothy Maher, M-A-H-E-R,
13	representing Becky Cole who is present at counsel
14	table.
15	THE COURT: All right. Now I understand you
16	have a resolution. This matter was here for trial
17	today. I understand you have a resolution. I believe
18	is it Ms. Cole's going to put that on the record or
19	both? Why don't you go ahead?
20	MS. CYLKOWSKI: Ms. Cylkowski. Yes, I will
21	put that on the record, Your Honor. In no particular
22	order, Mr. VanMeveren will pay to the defendant \$5,000.
23	He will provide that payment to my office today through
24	my law pay account. It takes five days to clear the
25	account. After which I will mail a check to

- 1 Mr. Maher's office payable to Becky Cole.
- 2 A statement will be made off the record in
- 3 the presence of the parties and counsel only. It's a
- 4 private statement not to be recorded and not repeated
- 5 at any time to anyone.
- 6 This record will be sealed. The parties have
- 7 also agreed to a confidentiality provision regarding
- 8 the entire agreement, and if asked the parties may
- 9 respond only using the phrase quote, "the case has been
- 10 resolved."
- The parties have agreed to a mutual
- 12 non-disparagement clause for which liquidated damages
- 13 would apply upon a breach of that clause in the amount
- of \$20,000 plus attorneys fees.
- 15 This matter will not be appealed. There will
- be no reopening of the case of any kind. This
- 17 agreement result resolves all possible claims between
- the parties of today's date that could have been raised
- whether foreseen or unforeseen.
- The conciliation court matter, which
- 21 apparently is still pending -- I am sorry I don't have
- 22 that court file number -- is also dismissed as part of
- this matter.
- MR. MAHER: I believe that that number is
- 25 62-C0-21-1039.

THE COURT: Okay. 1 2 MR. MAHER: I believe so. 3 MS. CYLKOWSKI: Thank you. I believe that's 4 everything. 5 MR. MAHER: Yes. And I would simply clarify, 6 although, it's accurate from what counsel said that the 7 only claims that could remain from this day forward are 8 breaches of this agreement. So everything as of today 9 is settled, but that doesn't prevent any party from 10 addressing a breach of this settlement agreement. 11 THE COURT: Okay. All right. 12 MR. MAHER: Now, do you understand what she 13 just outlined? 14 MS. COLE: Yeah. 15 MR. MAHER: Okay. And you are willing to go 16 forward with it? 17 MS. COLE: Yeah. 18 MS. CYLKOWSKI: Okay. Mr. VanMeveren, do you understand everything I just stated on the record? 19 20 MR. VANMEVERN: I do. 21 MS. CYLKOWSKI: And you are willing to move 22 forward with this final agreement? 23 MR. VANMEVERN: I am. 24 MS. CYLKOWSKI: And you understand it's final

as of today; it may not be opened for any purpose other

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1	than breach?
2	MR. VANMEVERN: That's correct.
3	MS. CYLKOWSKI: Thank you.
4	THE COURT: I want to make sure both parties
5	understand that you are here for trial. We could have
6	gone forward with the trial. You are choosing not to
7	do that. You are choosing to settle any claim that was
8	or could have been asserted as of today's date, right,
9	and this ends the matter today here.
10	The Court will enter an order sealing this
11	resolution. It will not be public. And it will not be
12	transcribed in any way without the Court unsealing the
13	record. All right. I think with that, we can be done.
14	MS. CYLKOWSKI: Okay.
15	MR. MAHER: Thank you, Your Honor.
16	MS. CYLKOWSKI: Thank you. Thank you, Your
17	Honor.
