

# Great Smoky Mountains National Park

## Parking Tag Information

Parking tags are required for all vehicles parking for longer than 15 minutes in Great Smoky Mountains National Park. While the parking tag is not an entrance fee, the park honors Free Entrance Days and parking tags will not be required on those dates.

## Parking Tag Basics

<b>Daily</b>	<b>\$5</b>
<b>Weekly</b>	<b>\$15</b>
<b>Annual</b>	<b>\$40</b>

- Parking tags are not replaceable, refundable, transferable, or upgradable.
- Each tag is valid for a single vehicle and must include a license plate number matching the vehicle.
- Parking tags are available for purchase both online and onsite.
- Display of physical parking tags in each vehicle is required. Digital representations are not accepted.
- Parking tags are not location-specific.
- Parking tags are not required for motorists who pass through or park less than 15 minutes.
- Interagency passes are not accepted in lieu of a parking tag.

## Display Your Parking Tag

Annual tags → front, lower passenger side windshield.

Daily/Weekly tags → face-up on the front, lower passenger side dashboard.
