

God's Food Pantry News

Starting in July we will open the pantry to in house shopping - We will still fill shopping list if you choose this option

These changes will be made for in person shopping in order to accommodate everyone and be done by 11 AM:

- Last shopper into the pantry 10:45 AM
- Masks will need to be worn when shopping, and while waiting for your turn to shop, we will limit 6 persons in the waiting area to shop. Please be sure to wear the masks to cover your nose and mouth.
- A volunteer will come and get the next person to shop.
- No outside carts, boxes or bags, will use the carts we have
- Only one (1) family person to shop, a limit of persons in the pantry to shop will in effect to maintain social distancing. Each person may only shop for their family.
- A time limit will be in effect in order to accommodate all
- Will shop with a volunteer, who will have a time and a clicker to track points.
- Point system being overhauled
- A 10-minute time limit for shopping, upon completion of shopping you will need to push the cart to your vehicle and bag/box at your vehicle. This is necessary due to the limit on the number of persons to shop
- When you check in at the June pantry you will let Mary Sue know which option you choose, you may always change.

This is a start to opening the pantry. I am sure we will be making changes as we go along each month, the time limit is short due to the number of families we are accommodating each month. All of this will probably be changing each month as we move through this.

It is possible that a person who choose to have us shop for them may get their boxes of food before the ones waiting to shop.
