## Method for Syllable Division

1. Underline the vowels that can make a sound.
2. Cross out silent vowels. (make)
3. Count the underlined vowels and you will know how many syllables the word has.
4. Divide between consonants:
ban $\backslash$ dits ex $\backslash$ pand com $\backslash$ bat
$v c c v \quad v c c v \quad v c \quad c v$

Keep consonant blends and digraphs together
tan $\backslash$ trum pam $\backslash p h l e t$
$v c \quad c v \quad v c \quad c c v$
If there is only one consonant in the middle, try putting it with the second syllable:
si \lent
$v c v$
re \fund
de $\backslash p e n d$
$v c v$
$v \quad c v$

If this does not form a recognizable word, put the consonant back with the first syllable:
lim \it
sol $\backslash i d$
clin $\backslash i c$
$v c \quad v$
$v c v$
$v c \quad v$
5. If there is a suffix such as $-e r$, $-i n g$, or $-f u l$, separate this from the rest of the word:

$$
\text { help } \backslash f u l \quad \text { bank } \backslash e r \quad \text { lift } \backslash \text { ing }
$$
