## **Method for Syllable Division**

- 1. <u>Underline the vowels</u> that can make a sound.
- 2. Cross out silent vowels. (make)
- **3. Count the underlined vowels** and you will know how many syllables the word has.
- 4. Divide between consonants:

ban \ dits ex \ pand com \ bat vc cv vc cv vc cv

## Keep consonant blends and digraphs together

 $tan \setminus trum$   $pam \setminus phlet$   $vc \quad c \quad v$   $vc \quad c \quad cv$ 

## If there is only one consonant in the middle, try putting it with the second syllable:

 $si \setminus lent$   $re \setminus fund$   $de \setminus pend$  $v \ cv$   $v \ cv$ 

## If this does not form a recognizable word, put the consonant back with the first syllable:

**5.** If there is a suffix such as -er, -ing, or -ful, separate this from the rest of the word:

 $help \setminus ful$   $bank \setminus er$   $lift \setminus ing$
