What you'll need:

- **2 oz. Blanco 100% Agave tequila**
- **.75 oz. simple syrup (to make, combine and stir one part granulated sugar and one part water)**
- **1 oz. lime juice**
- **2 cucumber wheels**
- **2 mint sprigs (or sage leaves)**

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- **2 oz. Blanco 100% Agave tequila**

- **1 oz. Fords Gin**
- **1 oz. lemon juice**
- **75 oz. Aperol**
- **.25 Giffard's orgeat syrup**

St. Louis Bellini



What you'll need:

- 1 oz. ginger vodka
- 1/2 oz. of elderflower liquor
- 1 oz. Sauvignon Blanc
- Dry Champagne

Tangerini



What you'll need:

- 1 oz. tangerine schnapps
- 1 oz. vodka
- Tangerine juice
- Orange/tangerine peel, for garnish

Tequila Eastside



What you'll need:

- 3/4 oz. fresh lemon juice
- 3/4 oz. honey syrup (combine and stir two parts honey, one part water)
- 2 oz. bourbon
- 2-3 fresh strawberries

Pineapple Daiquiri



What you'll need:

- 1 oz. fresh lime juice
- 3/4 oz. simple syrup (combine and stir one part granulated sugar and one part water)
- 2 oz. aged or white rum
- pineapple wedge

Appletini



What you'll need:

- 2.5 oz. sour apple liqueur
- 2 oz. vodka
- Sour mix and triple sec to taste
- Apple wedge, for garnish

Cosmopolitan



What you'll need:

- 2 oz. Blanco 100% Agave tequila
- .75 oz. simple syrup (to make, combine and stir one part granulated sugar and one part water)
- 1 oz. lime juice
- 2 cucumber wheels
- 2 mint sprigs (or sage leaves)

Loverlee-tini

What you'll need:

- wedge
- Pink cocktail glass rimmer (raspberry would be delicious)
- 2 oz. citrus vodka
- 1 oz. cranberry juice
- 1 oz. orange-flavored liqueur
- 3/4 oz. lime juice

What you'll need:

- Beefeater London Dry Gin
- Dubonnet
- pomegranate juice
- Lemonade
- Angostura bitters

Here are some great Wedding Punch recipes to try:

Traditional Blue Wedding Punch

2 quarts unsweetened pineapple juice
1-2 liter bottle 7-up
1-quart light rum
1 bottle Blue Curacao
1 can coconut cream

Southern Wedding Punch

2 fifths of Bourbon, or Tennessee Whiskey'
2 bottles club soda, or Canada Dry
1 pint strong-brewed Orange and Black Pekoe Tea (regular iced tea, but please do not use instant, or Sweet Tea) Sun Tea is a plus' ☐
12 oz. lemon juice
1-cup sugar

Champagne Punch

1 gal. Sauterne Wine
4 bottles champagne
2 bottles ginger ale
½ pint Sherbert

Wedding Sangria

1 (750 milliliter) bottle rose wine
1 (750 milliliter) bottle Burgundy wine
1 (46 fluid ounce) can pineapple juice (such as Dole®)
1 (2 liter) bottle fruit punch (such as Hawaiian Punch®)
1 lemon, juiced
