### NAME TAGS

Please always wear your name tag. There are 2 name tags in your packet, one for each the student and the accompanying adult. If you need more, please ask.

### LOCKERS

Lockers are available at no cost. Choose a locker in the basement of the Music Department. Bring your own lock. Please empty the locker at the end of the Institute.

The lockers are not big enough for full-size cellos. A secure room is provided to store instruments that are too big for the lockers. If you need the depot, you can sign out a key for the week. Please remember to return the key at the end of the week.

### STUDENT SOLO CONCERTS

Student Solo Concerts are an opportunity for pupils to perform in a comfortable concert setting. Attending concerts, of other musicians is an integral part of musical development. Young students learn good concert behaviour.

Leave and enter when you must, but please do it quietly and wait for a break in the program.

**Note carefully on your individual schedule the time and place of your rehearsal with the pianist.** If your piece is not in the Suzuki repertoire, you must bring a copy of the piano part to the accompanist-coach as soon as possible before the rehearsal. Pianists do not have a rehearsal time with an accompanist. Pianists' concert rooms are indicated on the individual schedule with the name of the accompanist who will be accompanying the string players in the same concert.

## JUNIOR CHAMBER ENSEMBLES, PIANO DUETS

The junior chamber music and piano ensemble teachers work with 2 ensembles per hour. The ensembles are set up in two different rooms. While the teacher works with one ensemble, the other ensemble practises. If additional practice time is needed, there is a suggestion for a practice time on your individual schedules. The junior ensembles and piano duets who have their classes after lunch during the week will have their Friday class at 11:15, just before the Ensembles Concerts at 12:15.

## MUSIC STANDS

Music stands must not be moved from one room to another without permission. Please bring portable stands.

## INDIVIDUAL LESSONS

Individual lessons (masterclasses) are given in groups of three or four pupils per hour. Each student receives individual instruction from the teacher and benefits from observing the other students' lessons. **Pupils are expected to stay for the duration of the hour.**

## CHOIR

We are delighted to offer choir under the inspired direction of Nathalie Rochette. Some students are scheduled for choir but it is open to all who are attending the Institute. If you have helpers like grand parents coming along, please encourage them to participate. Singing is good for your health. It relieves stress! This is a wonderful opportunity for parents and children to make music together. Don't miss it! Choose a time that suits you (10:45, 13:40, 14:50) and show up at the first practice on Monday in H-139.
