After a 2-year hiatus due to COVID, we are pleased to be offering Every Child Can! and five levels of teacher development at Institut Suzuki Montréal this summer! This is the first time that we will be offering online teacher development along with our usual in-person format. With a few exceptions, all our classes will be offered in Hyflex mode, meaning that there will be participants online as well as in person in each class.

# **PREPARING FOR THE 2022 INSTITUTE**

All Teacher Trainees must be a member of the Suzuki Association of the Americas (SAA) before arriving at the Institute. If you are not a member or your membership has expired, please visit the <u>SAA website</u>.

**Reminder:** Teacher Training participants must have submitted the required audition to the SAA. Visit the <u>SAA website</u> for more information concerning audition requirements and the procedure to follow.

Practice the repertoire from the volume you will be studying. You are expected to play it from memory.

## Things to bring with you to the Institute or have on hand if you are online:

**Strings**: You must bring your instrument if coming in-person. If doing the course online, you must have your instrument with you as well. If coming in person, we can provide a music stand.

Pianists: If doing the course online you must have access to a piano.

Nurtured By Love by Shinichi Suzuki – Bring to class. Please read this book before the beginning of your course.

Teaching from the Balance Point by Ed Kreitman – required for Violins Volumes 1 and 2

**Recordings:** Please listen to the recording of the Volume that you will be studying before the start of your course.

For violinists: The Hilary Hahn recordings for the Volume that you will be studying.

For pianists: The Seizo Azuma recordings for the Volume that you will be studying.

For cellists: The Tsuyoshi Tsutsumi recordings for the Volume that you will be studying.

For all participants: The international edition of Suzuki repertoire for the instrument and level that you are studying.

## **SPECIFICS FOR ONLINE PARTICIPANTS**

It is highly recommended that you use a desktop or laptop. A tablet is not ideal, and a phone will not do.

Check your internet speed and make sure that it is appropriate.

Sound will be better if you use an Ethernet cable. An external microphone may enhance sound quality.

Pianists must place their device near a piano. You will be working at the keyboard in each session.

Hand-outs that were formerly printed will be sent by email. You may wish to print them.

Your week of teacher development will be a busy one. If you have plans for teaching or doing other activities, you might want to lighten your load so that you can focus on your course.

## MANDATORY ATTENDANCE

If registered in a Teacher Training class as a **participant** with the intention of receiving credit from the Suzuki Association of the Americas, you must attend all Teacher Development classes and complete the required observation hours for your course.

# **SCHEDULE: WHAT TO EXPECT**

On weekend days, you will spend the day with your teacher trainer. From Monday to Friday, in addition to spending 2 to 3 hours per day with your teacher trainer, you should plan on doing about 3 hours of observations. This includes watching "live" or video lessons (synchronous and asynchronous) for which you will be required turn in observation reports. You should also set time aside for course assignments and reading.

You will receive further information from the trainers themselves before the courses begin.
