1 x Front Panel



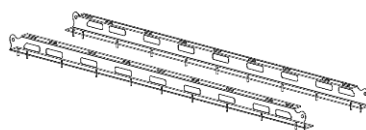

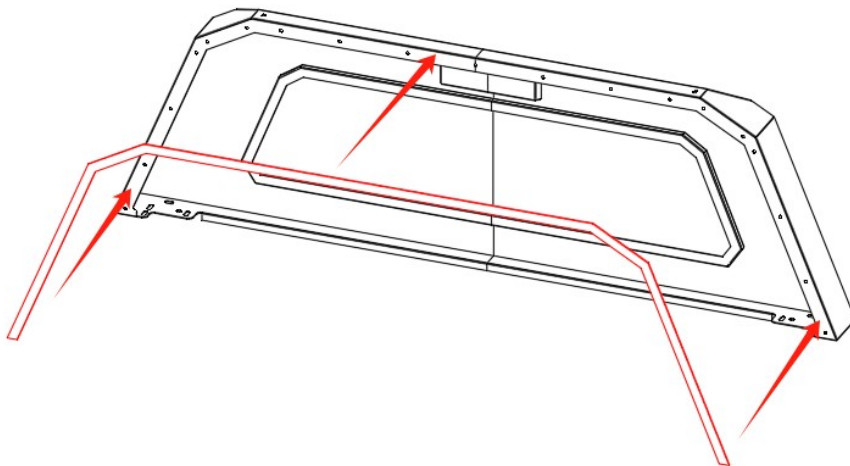
10mm Hexagon Flange Nuts

1. Attach seals to panels and parts

1.1 Attach the flat seals to the top rails. Make holes lining up with the bolts of the rails.

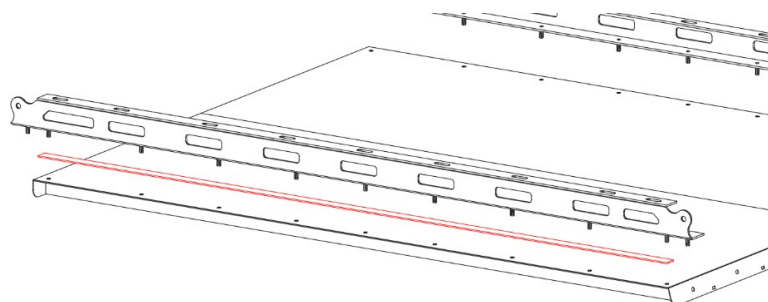


1.2 Attach the seals, which covers the holes of the panles, to the front , rear panels and side panels. And make holes.



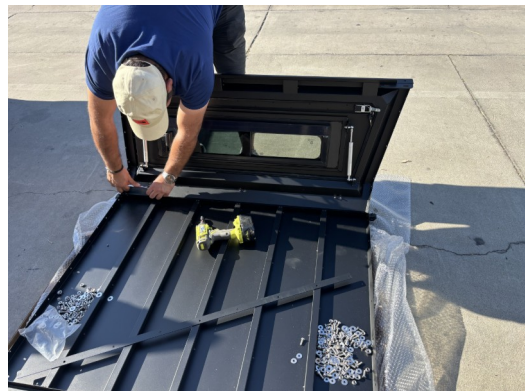
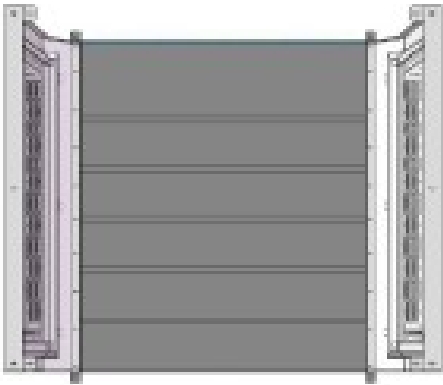


2. Attach the two top rails to the roof panel lining up with second bolts. Flip it after that.

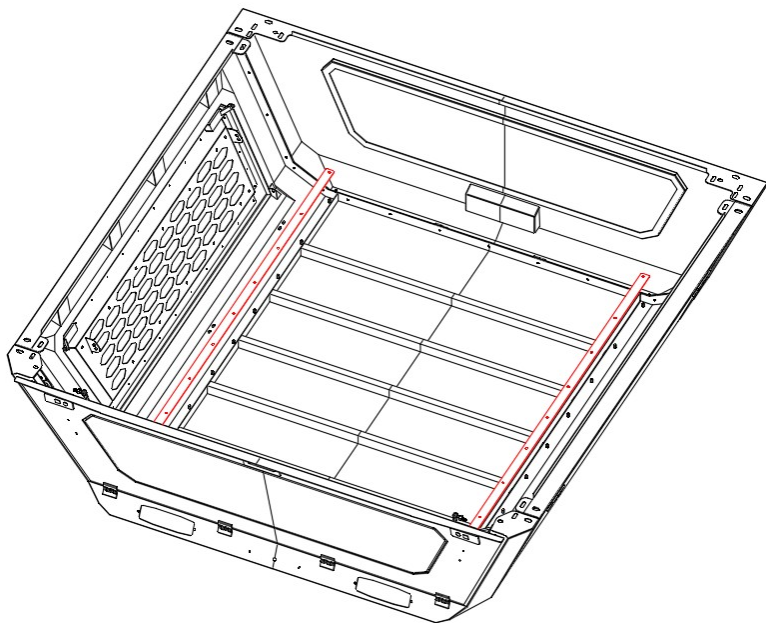




3. Attach two side panels to the roof panel which is combine with the top rails above.

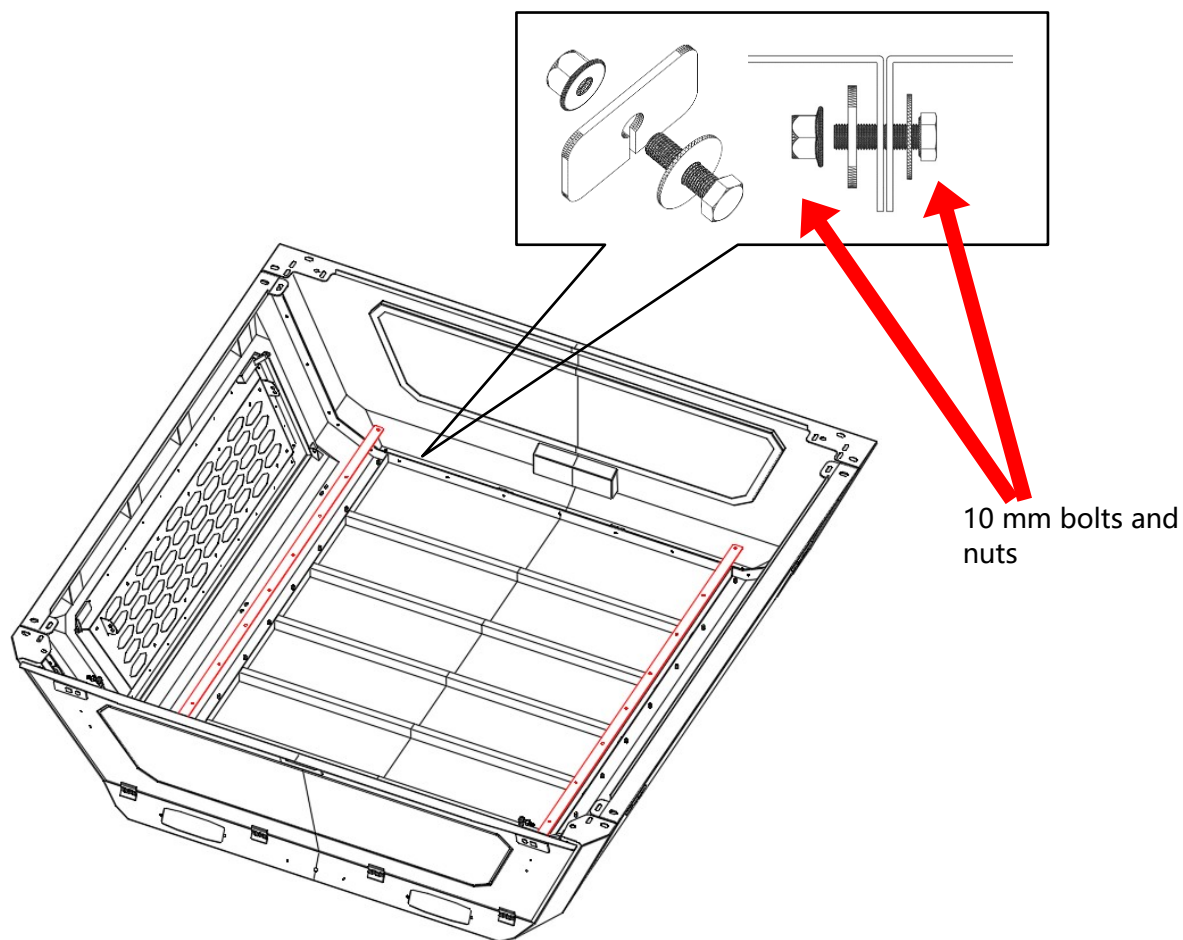


4. Put on two metal stricks, before screw down the two side panels.

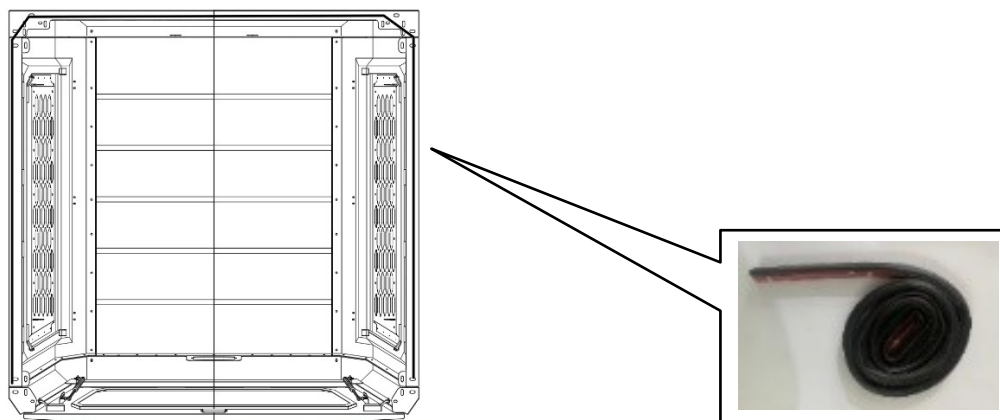


10 mm Nuts

5. Attach front and rear panels, and screw up.



6. Stick the weather strip along the outer edge of the camper shell like the picture shows.



7. Flip over the camper shell, and have at least 4 people to lift it to the truck bed. And use the C clamps to clamp it.

7.1 Use the black clamps for the one without bed rails system.



7.2 Use the silver clamps for the one with bed rails system.
