2026 Utility Rates

You will notice the new quarterly utility rates, as outlined below, are in effect on your enclosed invoice.

Water – 0 to 10,000 gallons	\$155.00	Water Infrastructure – Residence	\$50.00
Water – 10,001 gallons or more	\$30.00 per 1,000 gallons	Garbage	\$42.00
Sewer – Residences	\$85.00	Recycling	\$39.00

Collection, Removal and Disposal of Garbage and Recycling

As per Bylaw No. 1-2024, we would like to remind all residents of the following requirements:

- Garbage and recycling carts must be placed on the designated side of the street, at the street edge, no later than **7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day.**
- Carts must not remain at the set-out location after the day following collection. All carts must be **rolled back onto the designated property PROMPTLY** after pickup.
- All garbage shall be securely bagged or bundled in the container.
- All recyclable material shall be unbagged in the container;
- All waste shall fit in the cart with the cart lid closed;
- All waste shall be drained free of water before it is placed inside the container; and
- General medical waste, animal waste, dust particles and powered materials shall be double packaged in garbage bags and securely tied.

Back-alley pick-ups are intended for disposing of leaves, garden refuse, grass clippings, and similar yard waste.


If you are planning a large tree trimming or tree removal project, please contact the office to arrange use of the Village's trailer instead of leaving a large amount of material for Corley to handle.
