You will notice the new quarterly utility rates, as outlined below, are in effect on your enclosed invoice. \$155.00 Water Infrastructure – Residence Water - 0 to 10,000 gallons \$45.00 Water – 10,001 gallons or more \$30.00 per 1,000 gallons Water Infrastructure – Hotel \$90.00 Sewer – Residences \$80.00 Garbage \$42.00 Sewer – Hotel \$120.00 Recycling \$39.00


Please do not feed the deer in our Village. Feeding deer leads to:
