BYLAW NO. 5-2019

VILLAGE OF EARL GREY

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EARL GREY TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER, BY WAY OF RENT OR SERVICE CHARGE FOR THE USE OF SEWER, AND BY WAY OF SERVICE CHARGE FOR INFRASTRUCTURE

The Council of the Village of Earl Grey, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule "A" attached; provided, however, that the minimum shall be payable in every case whether or not any water is consumed.
- 2. Persons who own or occupy premises drained or that are by Bylaw required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such service a rental rate or service charge in accordance with Schedule "B" attached.
- 3. Persons who own or occupy premises drained into the waterworks and sanitary sewer system shall pay a sewer infrastructure fee in accordance with Schedule "C" attached.
- 4. Water consumers whose water service has been turned on shall pay a water infrastructure fee in accordance with Schedule "C" attached.
- 5. Consumers shall be invoiced quarterly on or about March 1st (for the preceding months of December, January and February), June 1st (for the preceding months of March, April and May), September 1st (for the preceding months of June, July and August), and December 1st (for the preceding months of September, October and November).
- 6. Accounts with a balance owing in excess of \$20.00 at the date of the next billing shall have a penalty in the amount of \$20.00 added to their account.
- 7. If the water supply is shut off to the premises of a consumer for infringement of the provisions of this Bylaw, same shall not be turned on until all penalties, fees, rates, charges, and arrears, if any, have been paid in full.
- 8. Consumers may be permitted to pay for water, sewer, and/or infrastructure charges in advance of billings or the date that such billings are due, however, that consumer shall not receive any discount off the base rate or total billing.
- 9. A decision of the court that one or more of the provisions of this Bylaw are invalid in whole or in part does not affect the validity, effectiveness or enforceability of the other provisions or parts thereof with respect to this Bylaw.
- 10. Bylaw No. 2-2017 is hereby repealed.

THE rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final approval being issued by the Local Government Committee of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
