

BYLAW 2-2011

**A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF EARL GREY TO REGULATE THE
WEIGHT OF VEHICLES ALLOWED IN THE VILLAGE OF EARL GREY**

The Council of the Village of Earl Grey, in the Province of Saskatchewan , enacts as follows:

1. No person shall operate any vehicle on any street within the corporate limits of the Village of Earl Grey weighing with or without its load more than three tonne.
2. Subject to Section 1 above, the Village of Earl Grey may issue an overweight permit which contains the following information:
 - (1) The name, address and date of the permittee.
 - (2) The license number of the vehicle, the gross vehicle weight and the number of axles.
 - (3) The streets necessary to travel on.
 - (4) The date and time the permit shall be valid from.
3. Permit fee shall be \$25.00 per single trip permit and \$100.00 per multi-trip permit.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction to this bylaw shall be subject to the fines of our general penalty bylaw.
